**A Standardized Treatment
Calendar**

- Another important innovation that the ADOC is implemented in January 2017 was a standardized treatment calendar. Telling at a glance where an individual is in relation to their individual treatment program.



Treatment Programs

- The Alabama Department of Corrections currently offer substance abuse treatment programs in 20 facilities throughout the state of Alabama
- In the Fiscal year 2016, ADOC provided treatment services to 3,216 incarcerated individuals, representing approximately 15% of the total incarcerated population in Alabama (22,944 total population)
