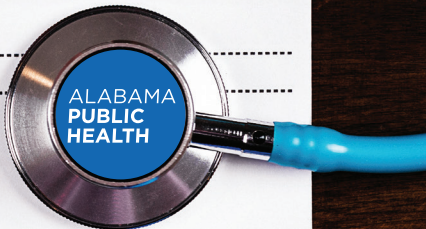

- Other than skin cancer, prostate cancer is the most common cancer diagnosed in men.
- More than 170,000 men will be diagnosed annually with prostate cancer in the United States, and over 4,000 will be diagnosed in Alabama.
- For African American men, prostate cancer tends to start at a younger age and grow faster than men of other races.
- If you have any symptoms that worry you, be sure to see your doctor right away.
