## CHECKLIST FOR DEVELOPMENT OF INFECTIOUS DISEASE PREVENTION PLAN

- ( ) Current method of generally maintaining infection control in both the service living/working quarters and on vehicles\*. Items to be addressed:
  - 1. Personal Hygiene and Hand Washing
  - 2. Use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
  - 3. Management of Sharps
  - 4. Clinical Waste Including Disposal of Sharps
  - 5. Linen
  - 6. Spillages of Blood and Body Fluids
  - 7. Cleaning, Repairs, and Servicing of Medical Devices and Vehicles
  - 8. General Cleaning for Ambulance/Fire Stations
- ( ) Current method of infection control while providing patient care.
- ( ) Current method of infection control after coming in contact with a patient, both on trucks and in/around service living/working quarters.
- ( ) Current policies regarding personnel when someone calls in sick or reports that they are sick while on duty.
- ( ) List of any specific infectious disease control trainings (such as Ebola).
- ( ) Method of how EMS personnel collect biohazardous waste produced or obtained by personnel, through patient care, from the scene of a prehospital incident, and how this waste is handled on the vehicle and in/around the living/working quarters.
