670-X-13-.06 ER Payment Of Accumulated Leave Upon Separation
From Service.

(1) Upon all separations from service except for a layoff, an employee shall be paid for the actual number of hours of annual leave he has accumulated, up to a maximum of 480 hours in an employee's career, with the amount being computed using the base hourly pay rate at the time of separation multiplied by the number of hours of leave due.

~~(2) Should an employee return to service, his absence must be for a longer period of time than the amount of annual leave paid.~~
