

- 1. Mpox virus is in the poxvirus family, which include the smallpox virus.
- 2. Mpox symptoms include: muscle aches, swollen lymph nodes, fever, headache, and rash.
- 3. Within one to three days after a fever, mpox is characterized by a rash of pustules that can commonly be found on the face, hands, feet, eyes, mouth and/or genitals.
- 4. Anyone can contract mpox. Mpox spreads through respiratory droplets, close physical contact, touching sores or body fluids, or touching personal belongings that have made contact with sores.
- 5. If you have symptoms, talk with a healthcare provider, isolate at home, avoid any close physical contact, and wear a mask when around others. The virus is able to resolve on its own after two to four weeks.
