In response to our question, the Department's Office of General Counsel advises that under the provision of <u>Code of Ala.1975</u>, Section 31-9-16, pharmacists who volunteer through the Department of Public Health as a Public Health Pharmacist Volunteer, during the declared emergency, will be immune from civil liability during the time they are in volunteer status as long as their actions conform to professional and legal standards. Wanton and willful misconduct, gross negligence or bad faith, however, will not be covered under the immunity statute.
