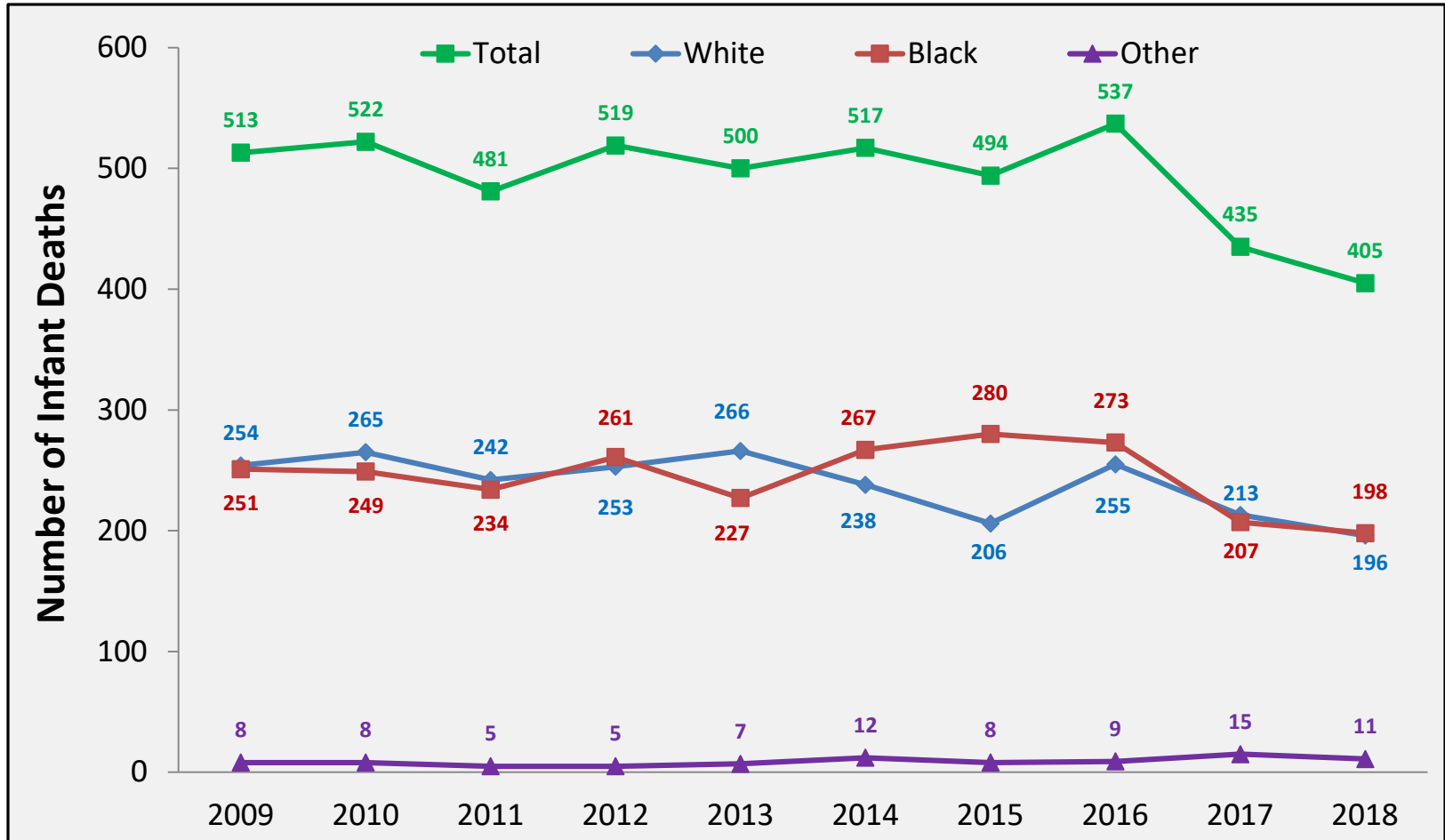

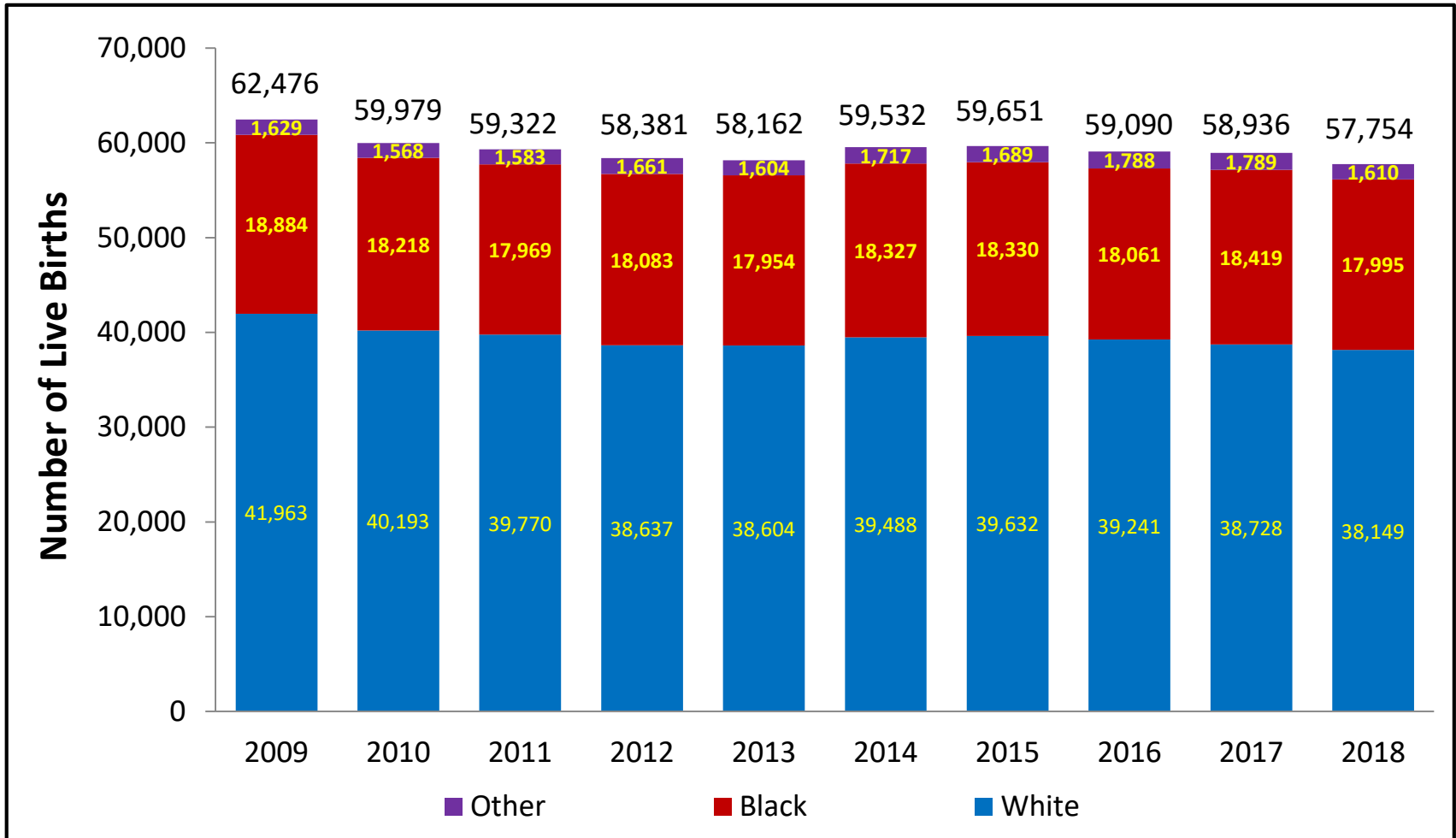
INFANT MORTALITY RATES ALABAMA, 2009-2018



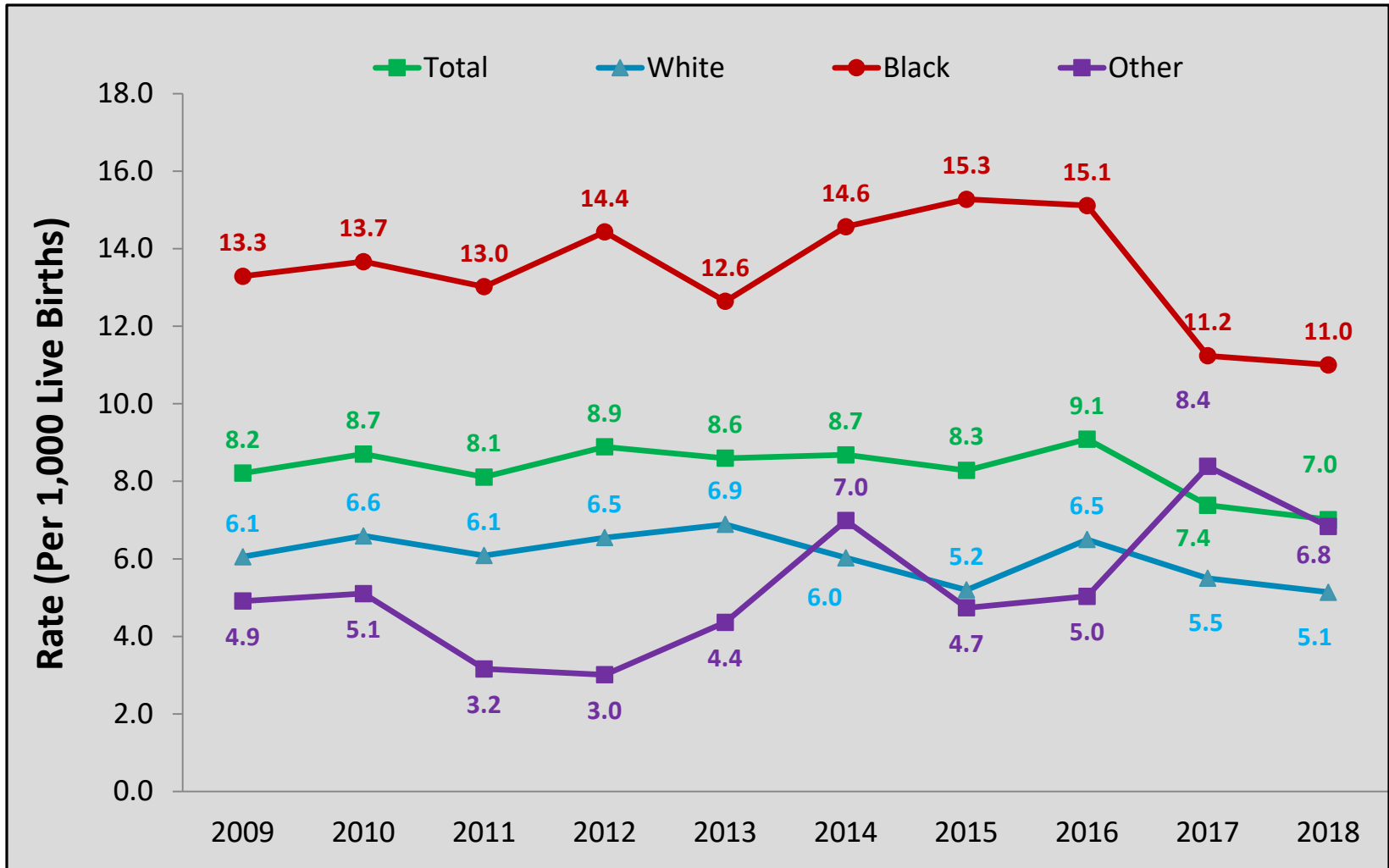
NUMBER OF INFANT DEATHS ALABAMA, 2009-2018



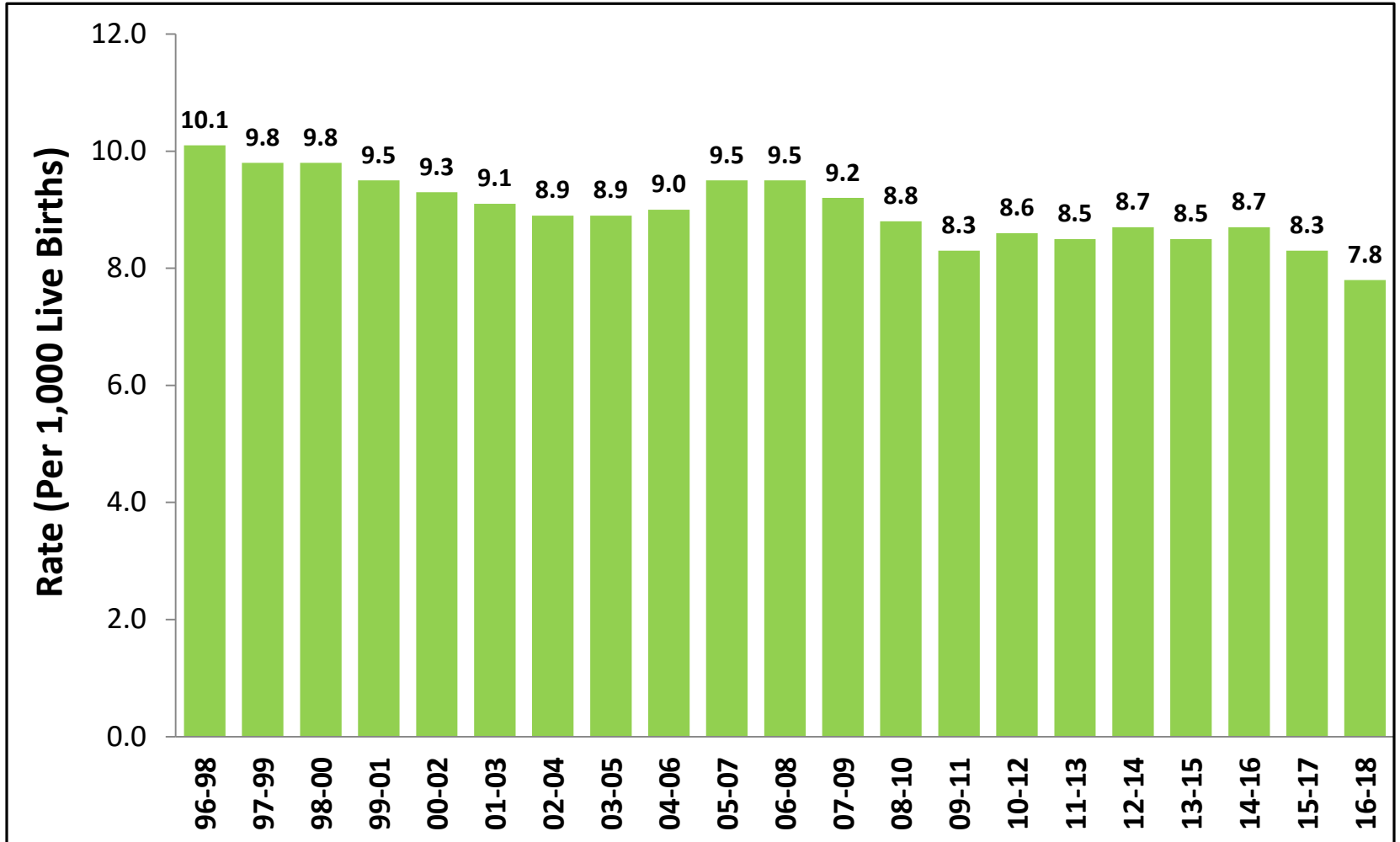

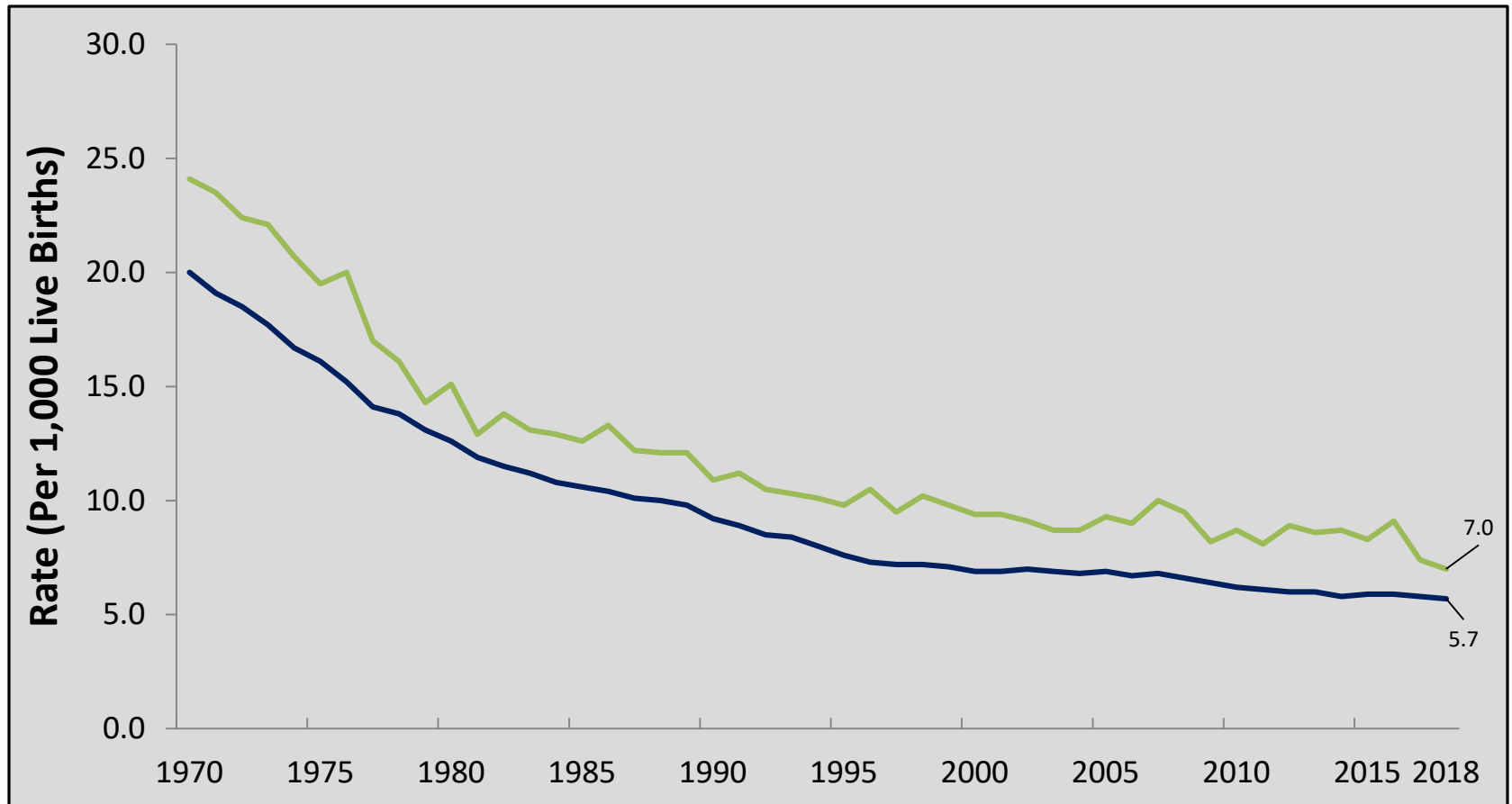

INFANT MORTALITY RATES ALABAMA AND UNITED STATES¹, 1970-2018



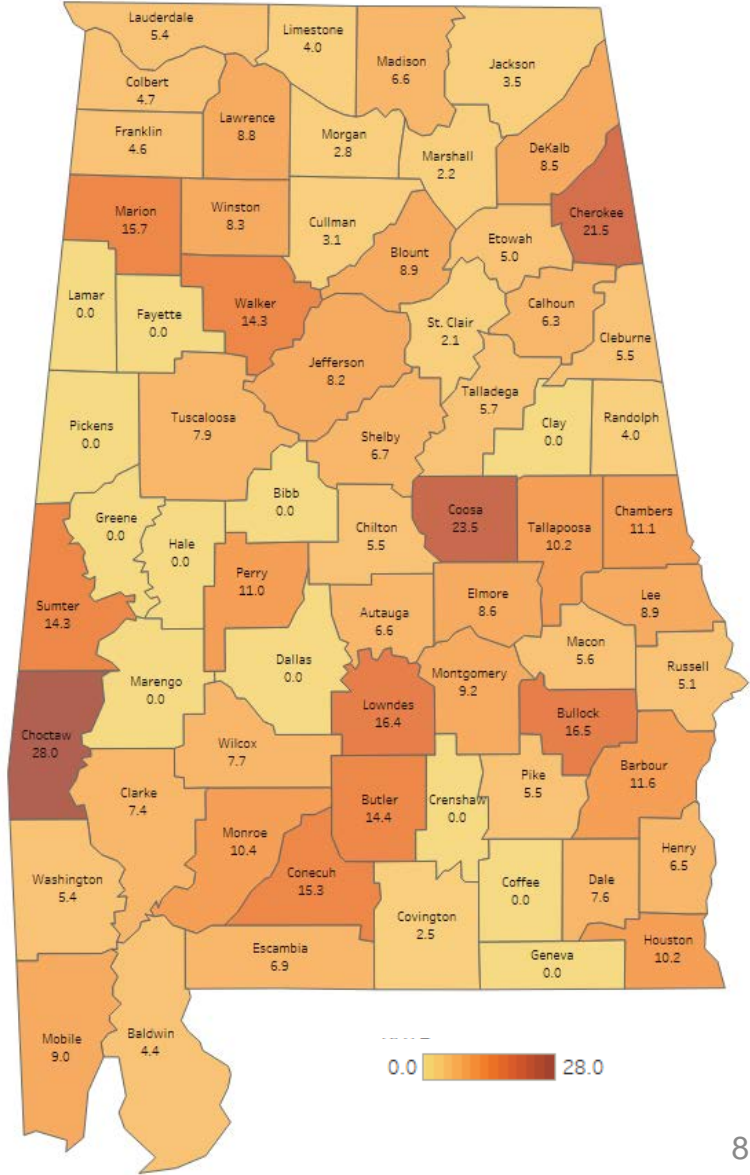
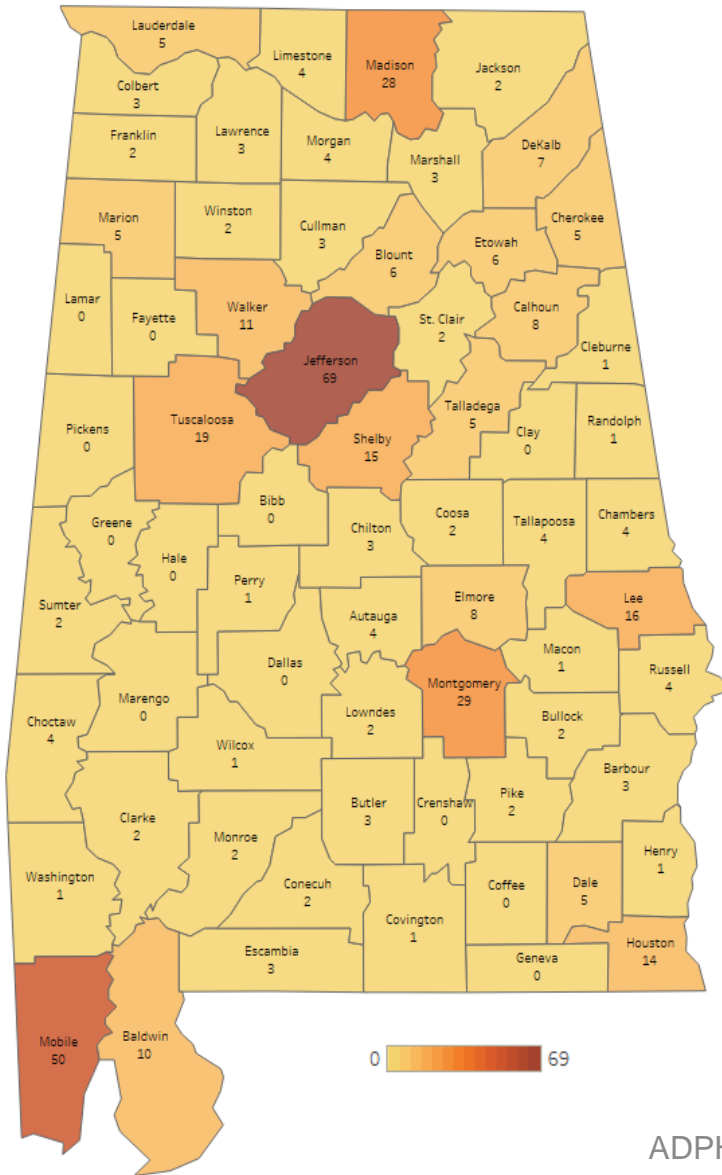

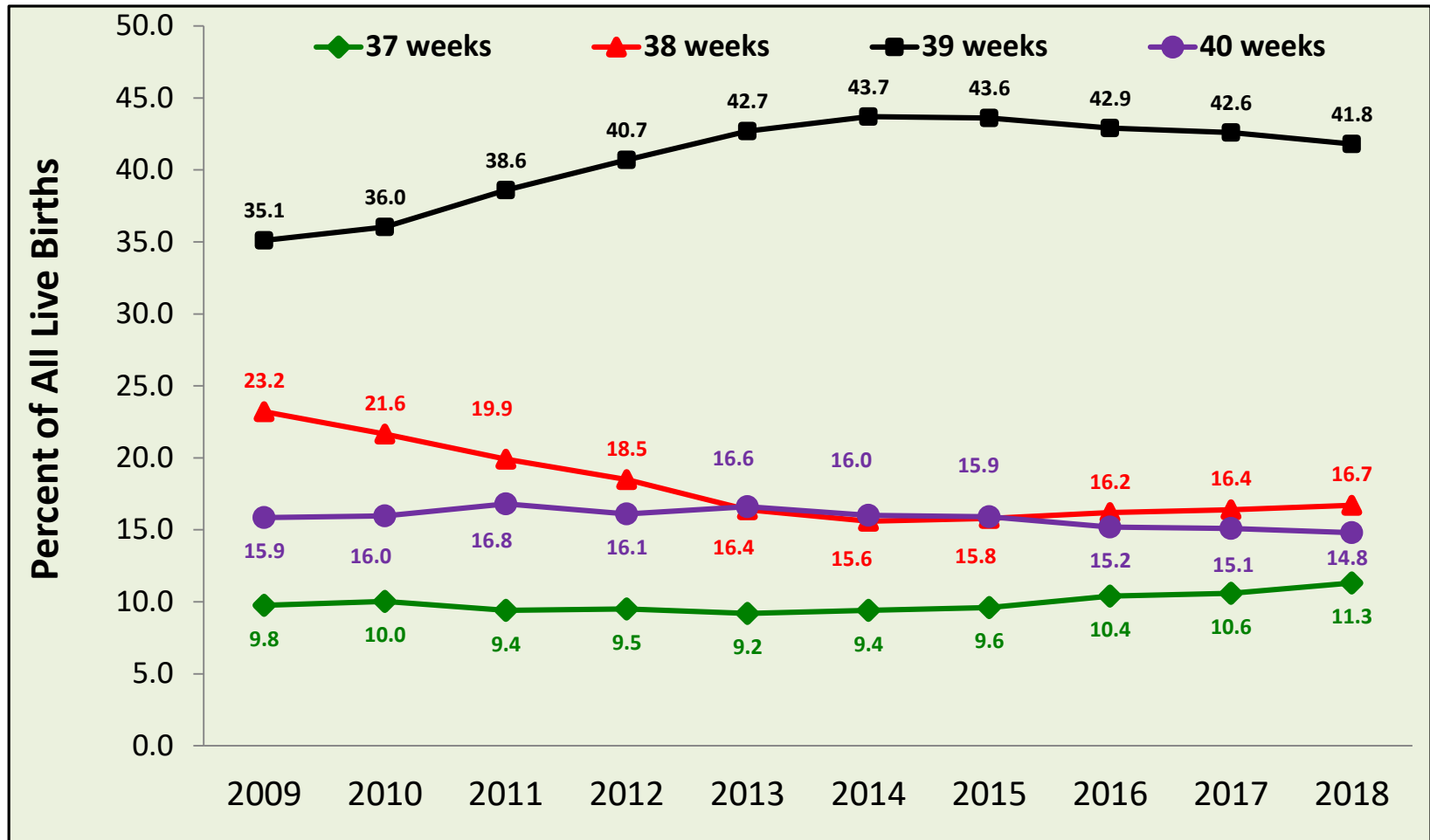

PERCENT OF BIRTHS AT 37 - 40 WEEKS GESTATION ALABAMA, 2009-2018

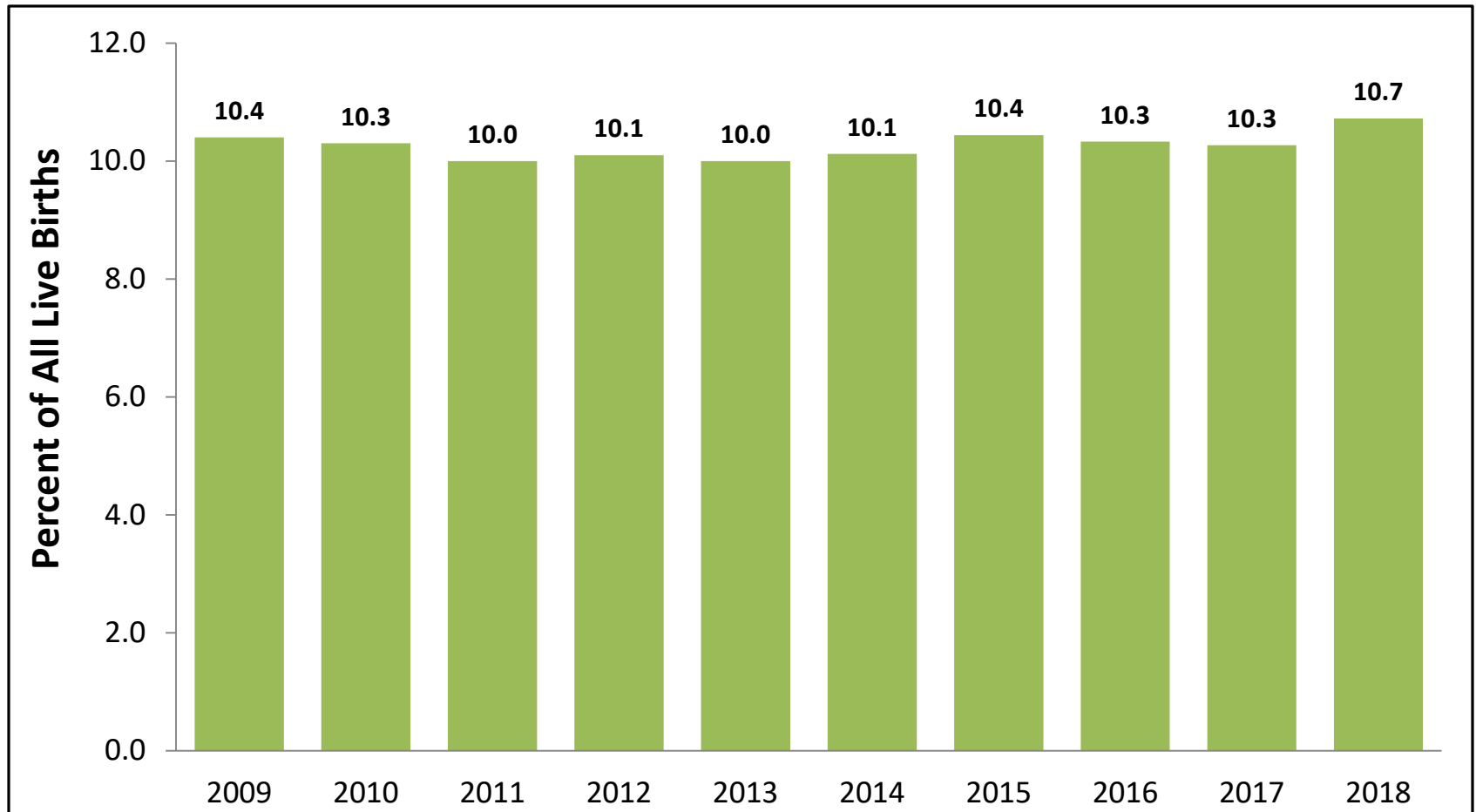


PERCENT OF BIRTHS LESS THAN 37 WEEKS GESTATION ALABAMA, 2009-2018



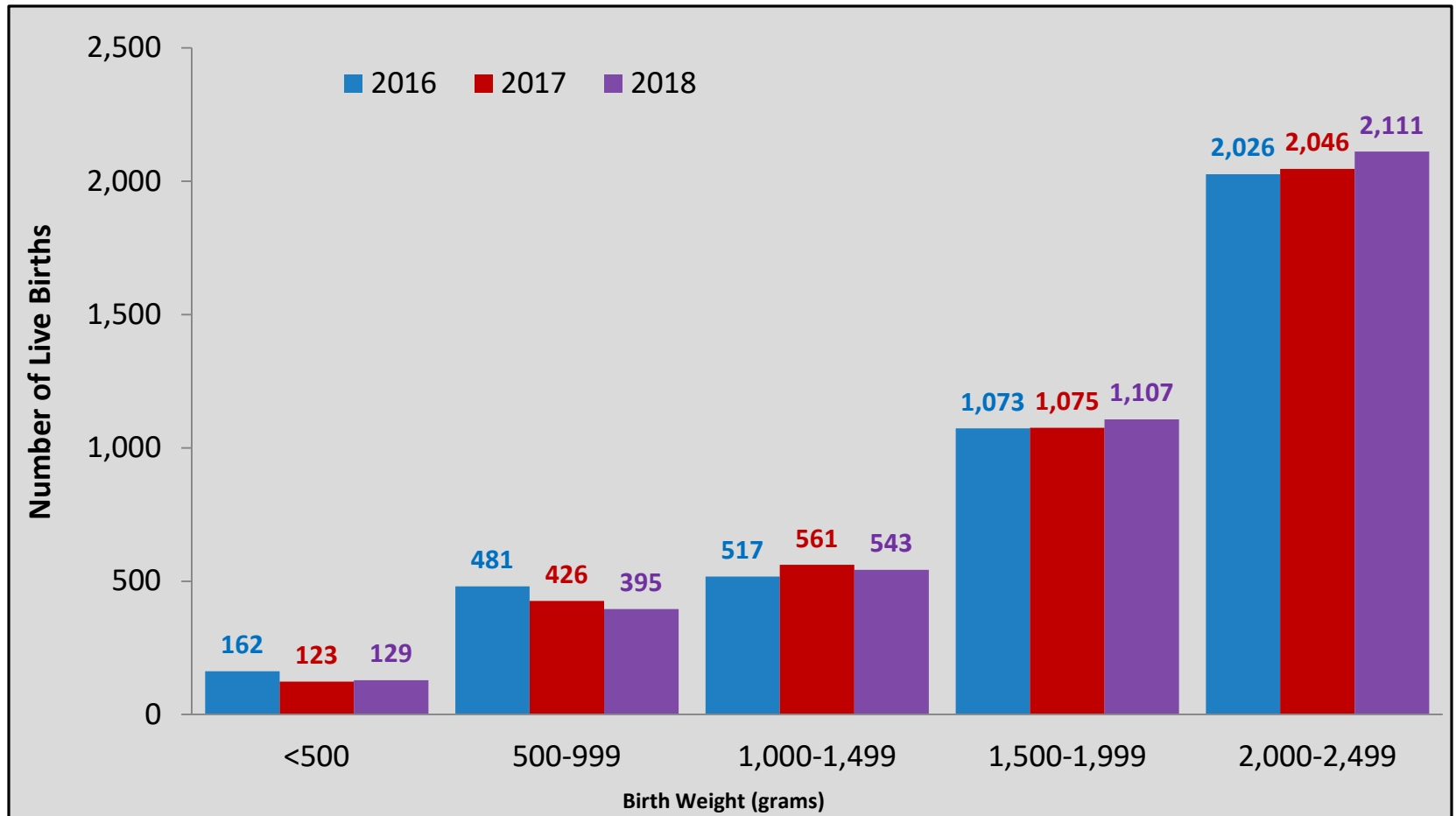
PERCENT OF LOW WEIGHT BIRTHS*

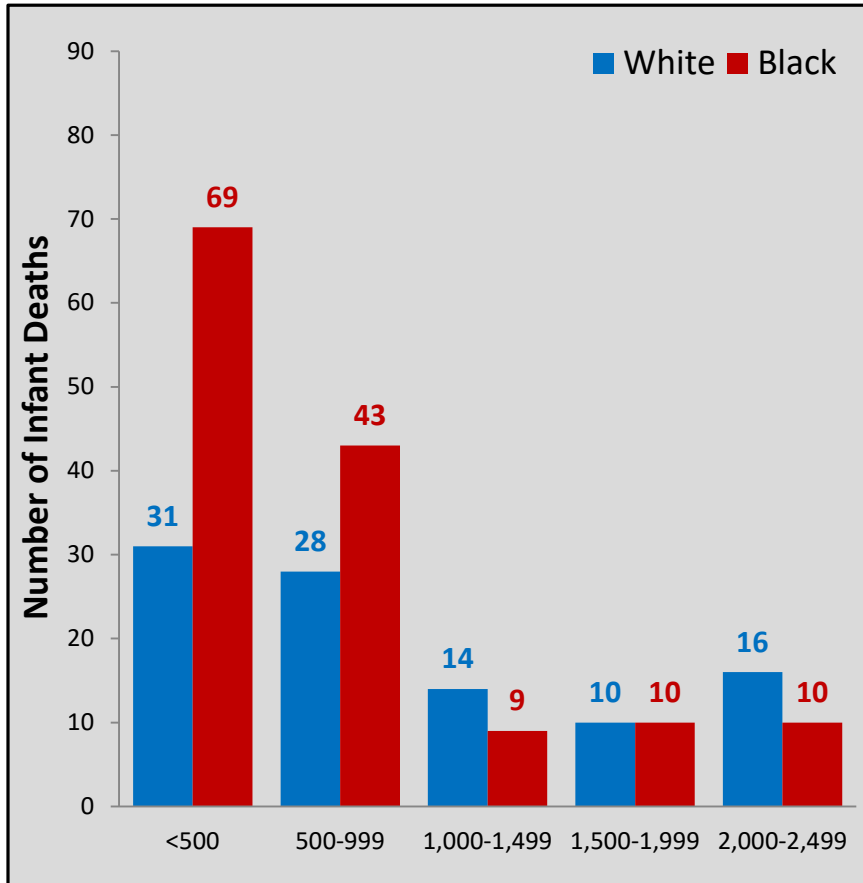
NUMBER OF PRETERM BIRTHS* BY BIRTH WEIGHT ALABAMA, 2016 - 2018



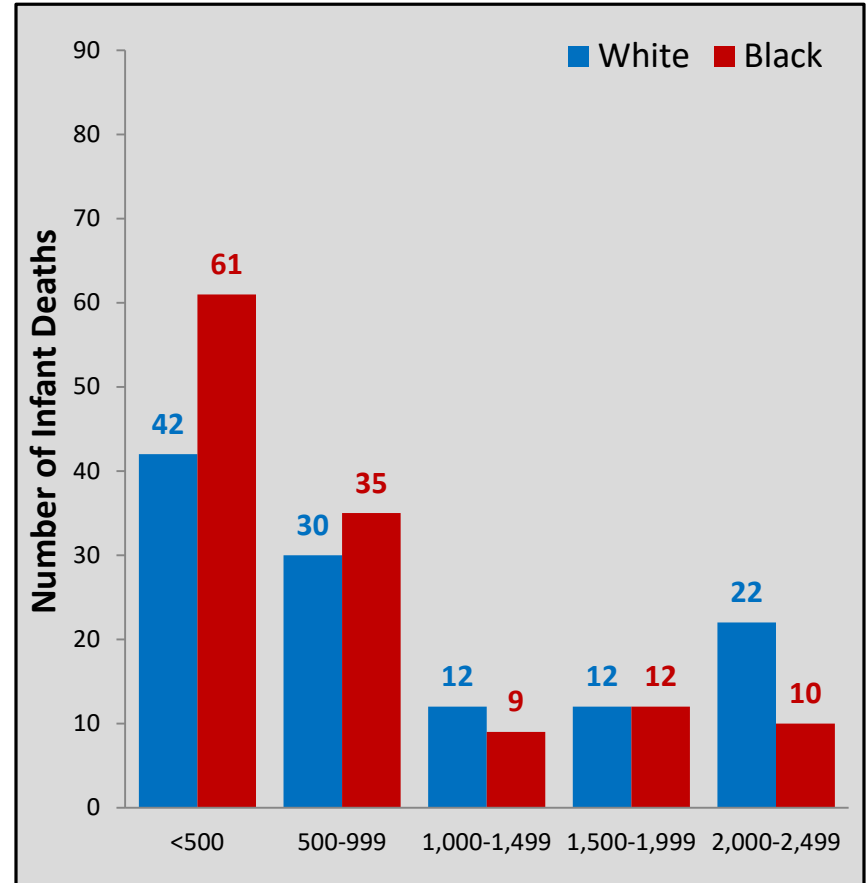

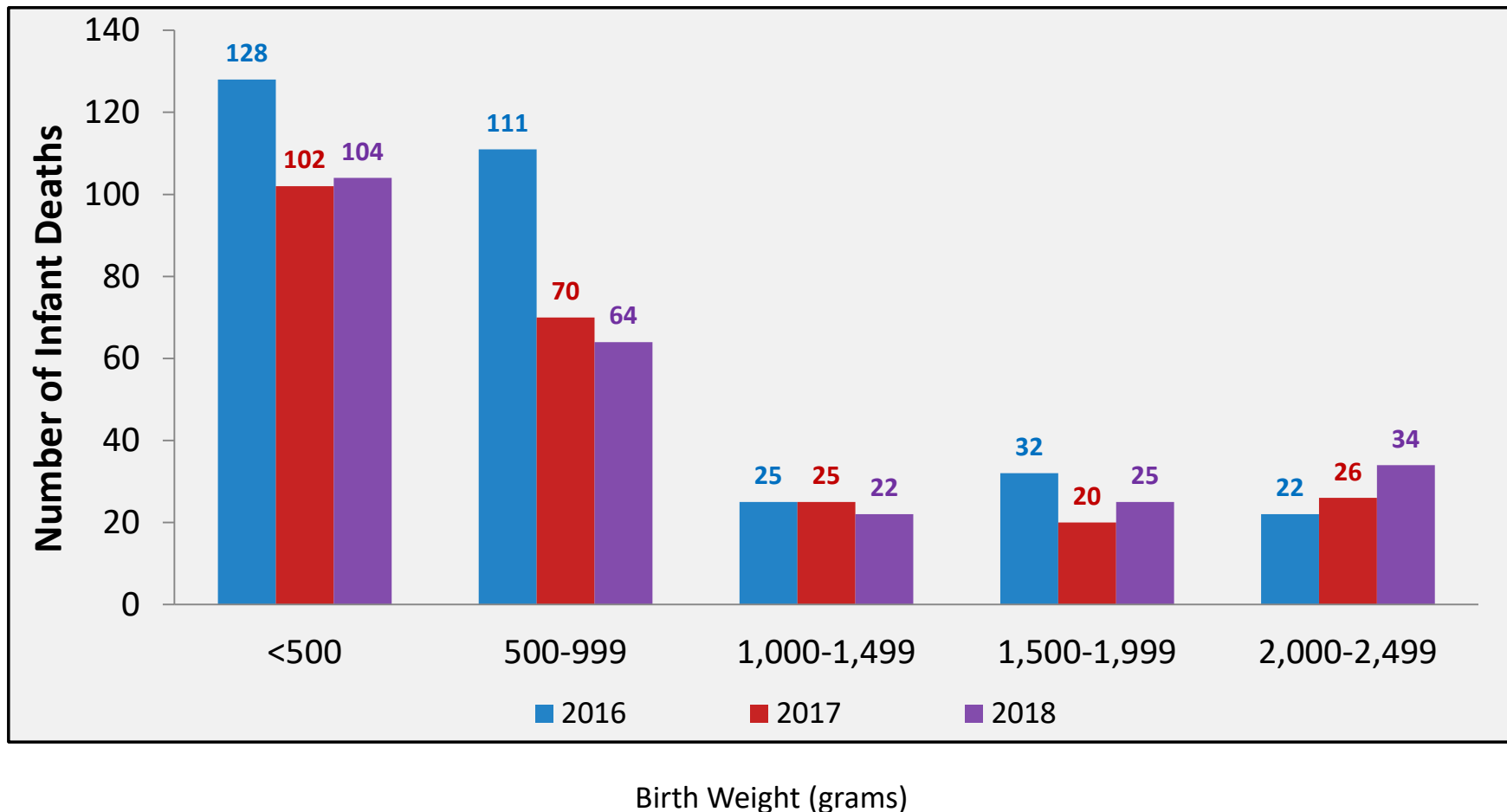

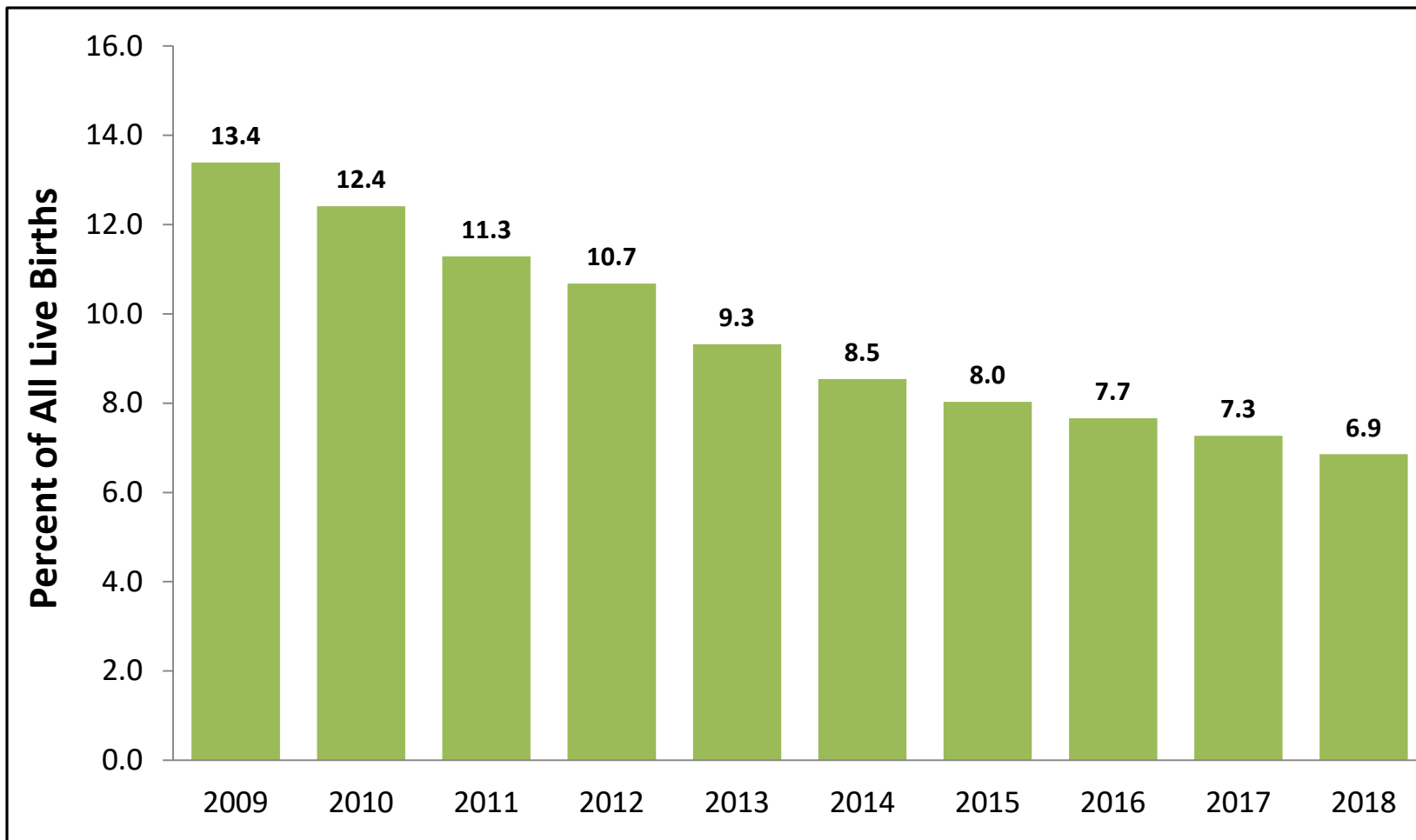

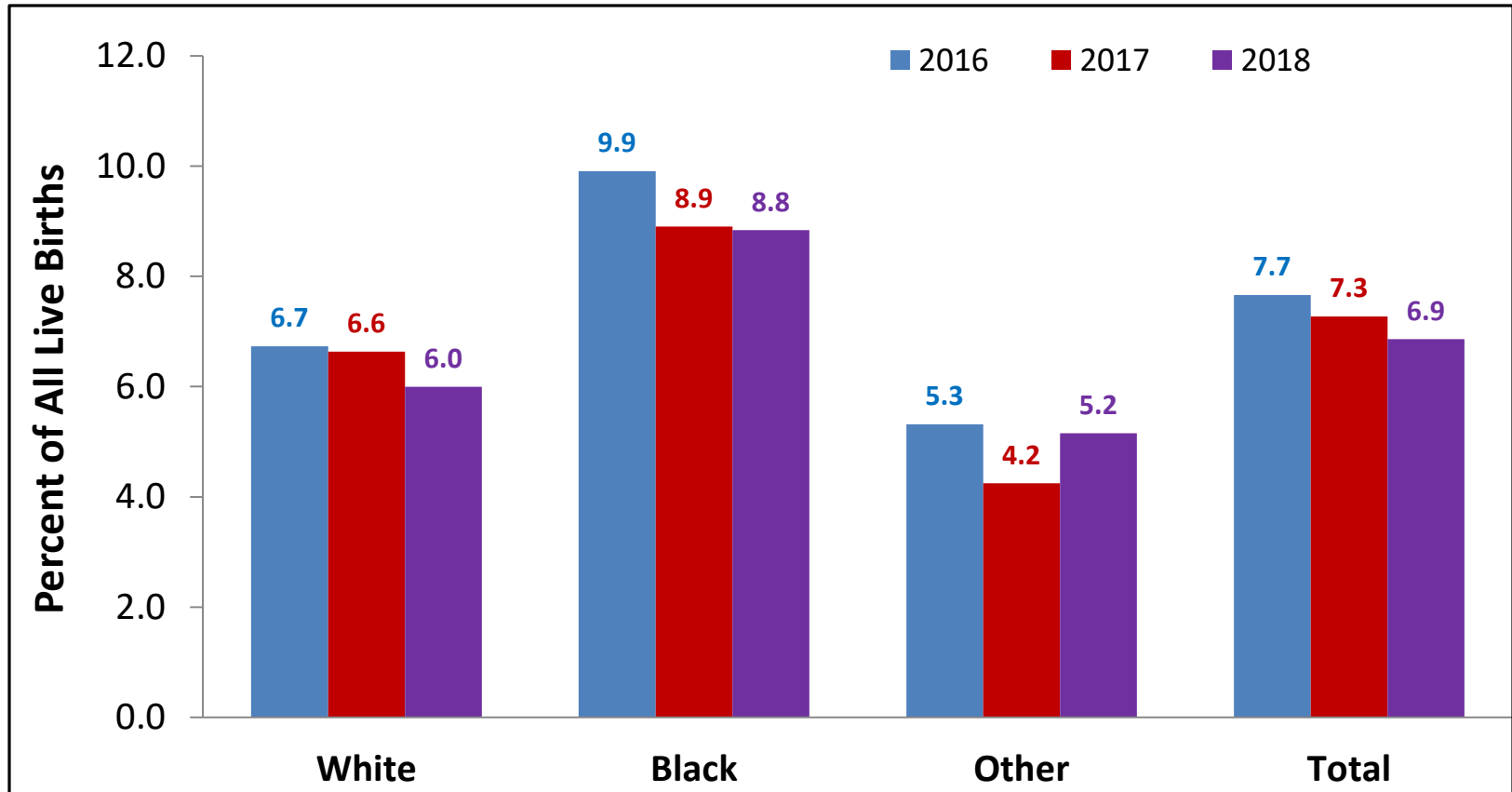
NUMBER OF INFANT DEATHS WITH PRETERM BIRTHS BY BIRTH WEIGHT ALABAMA, 2016 - 2018



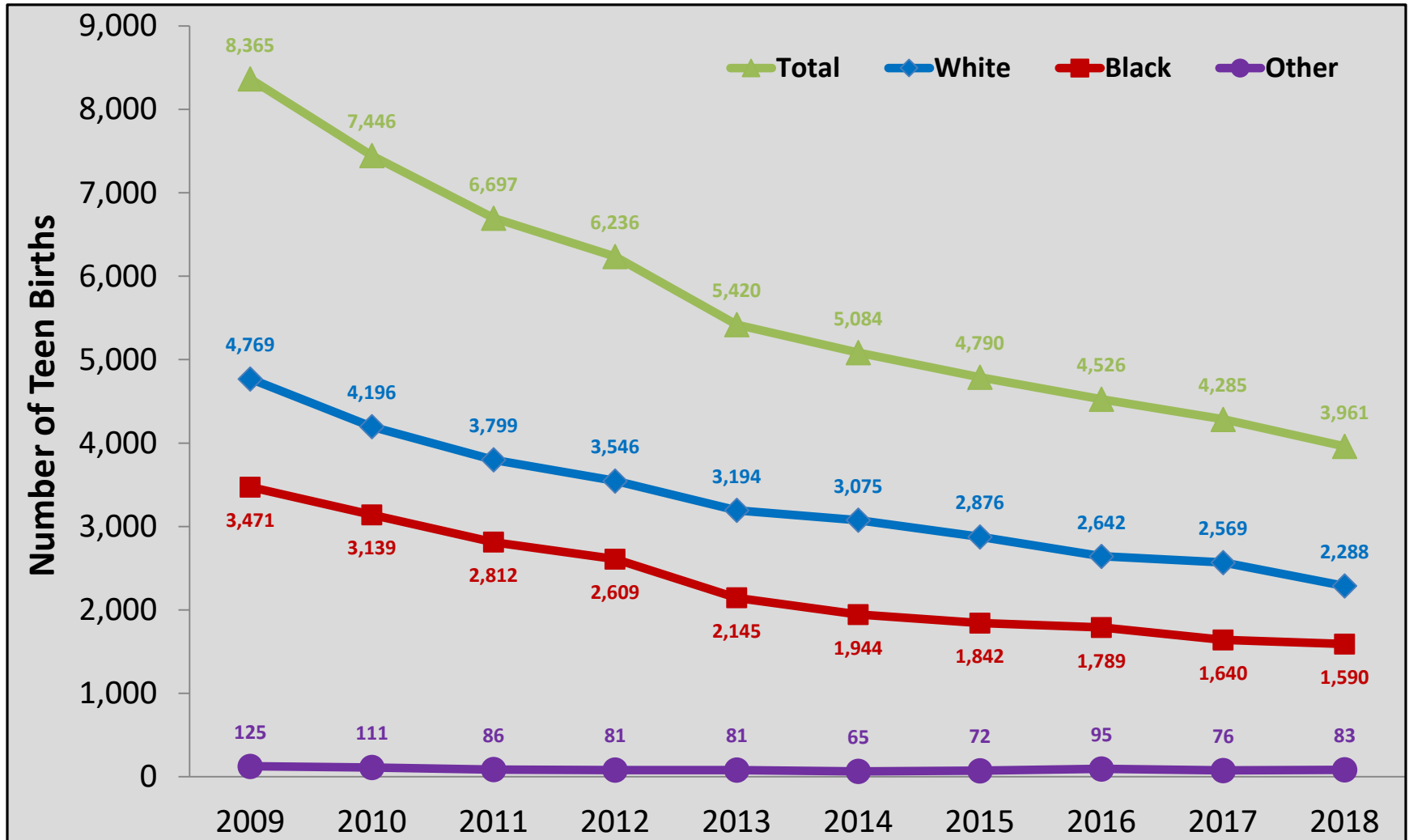
PERCENT OF BIRTHS TO TEENAGERS (AGES 10-19) ALABAMA, 2009-2018



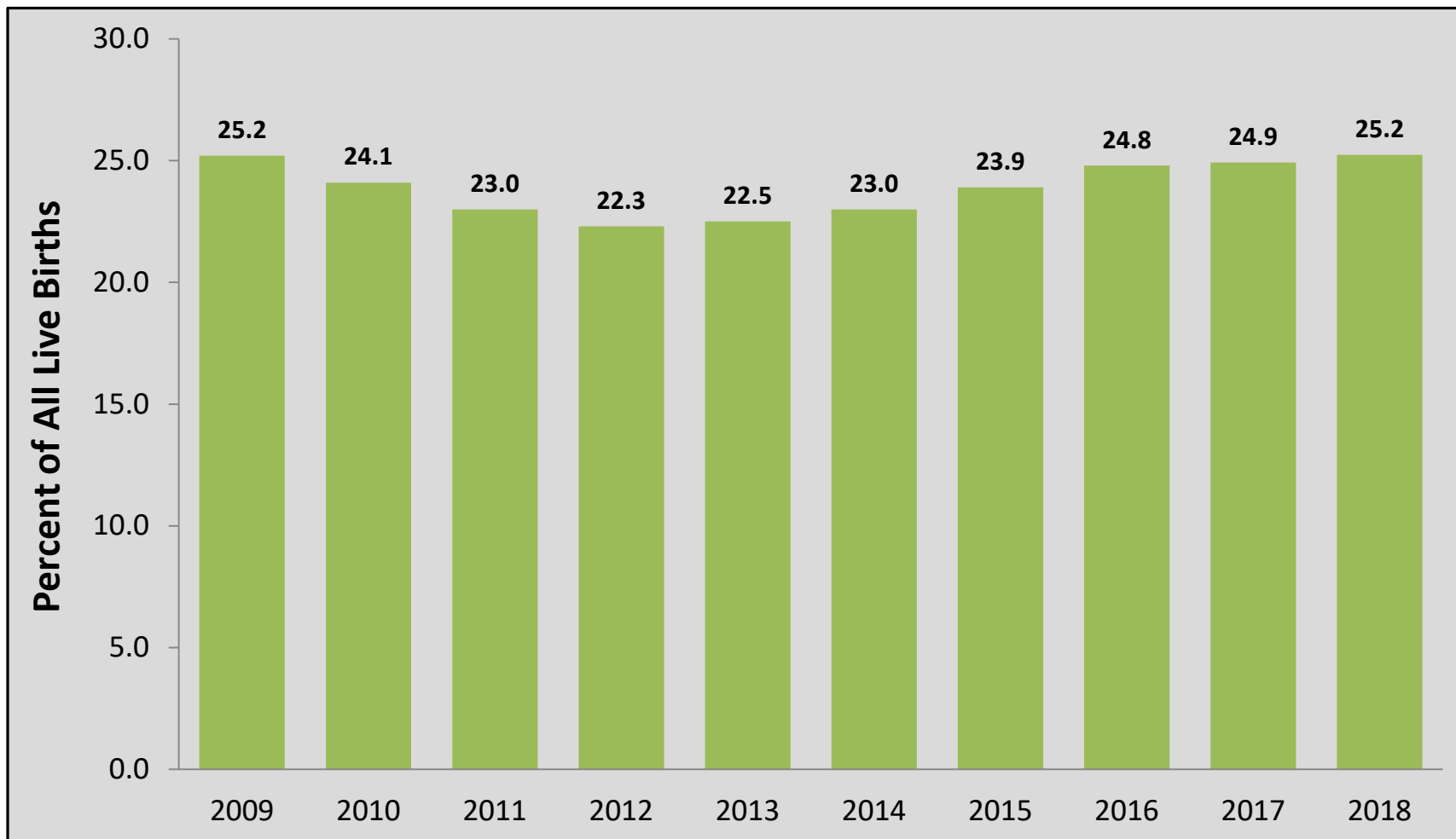
PERCENT OF BIRTHS TO TEENAGERS BY RACE (AGES 10-19) ALABAMA, 2016 - 2018



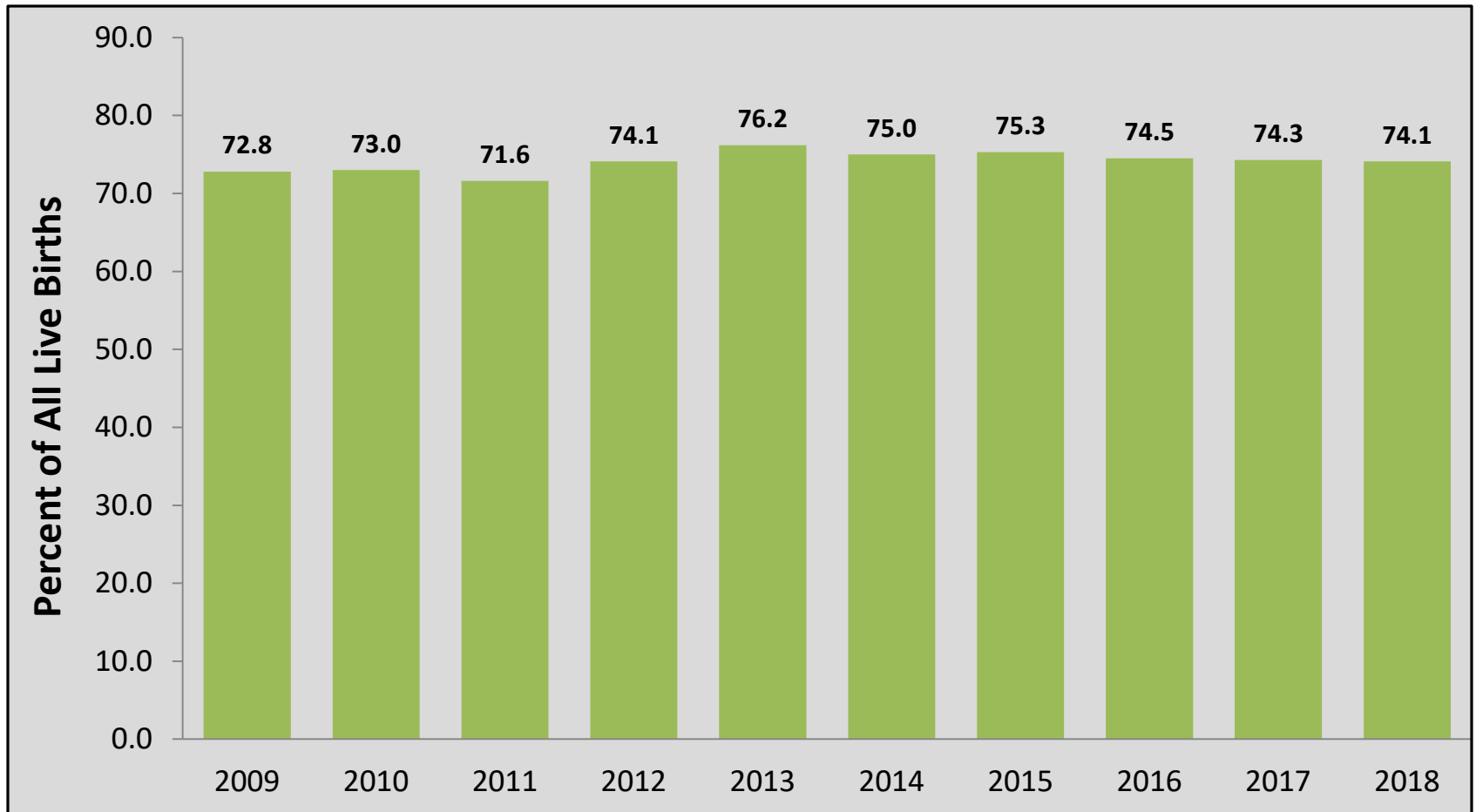

PERCENT OF BIRTHS WITH A BIRTH INTERVAL LESS THAN 2 YEARS, ALABAMA, 2009-2018

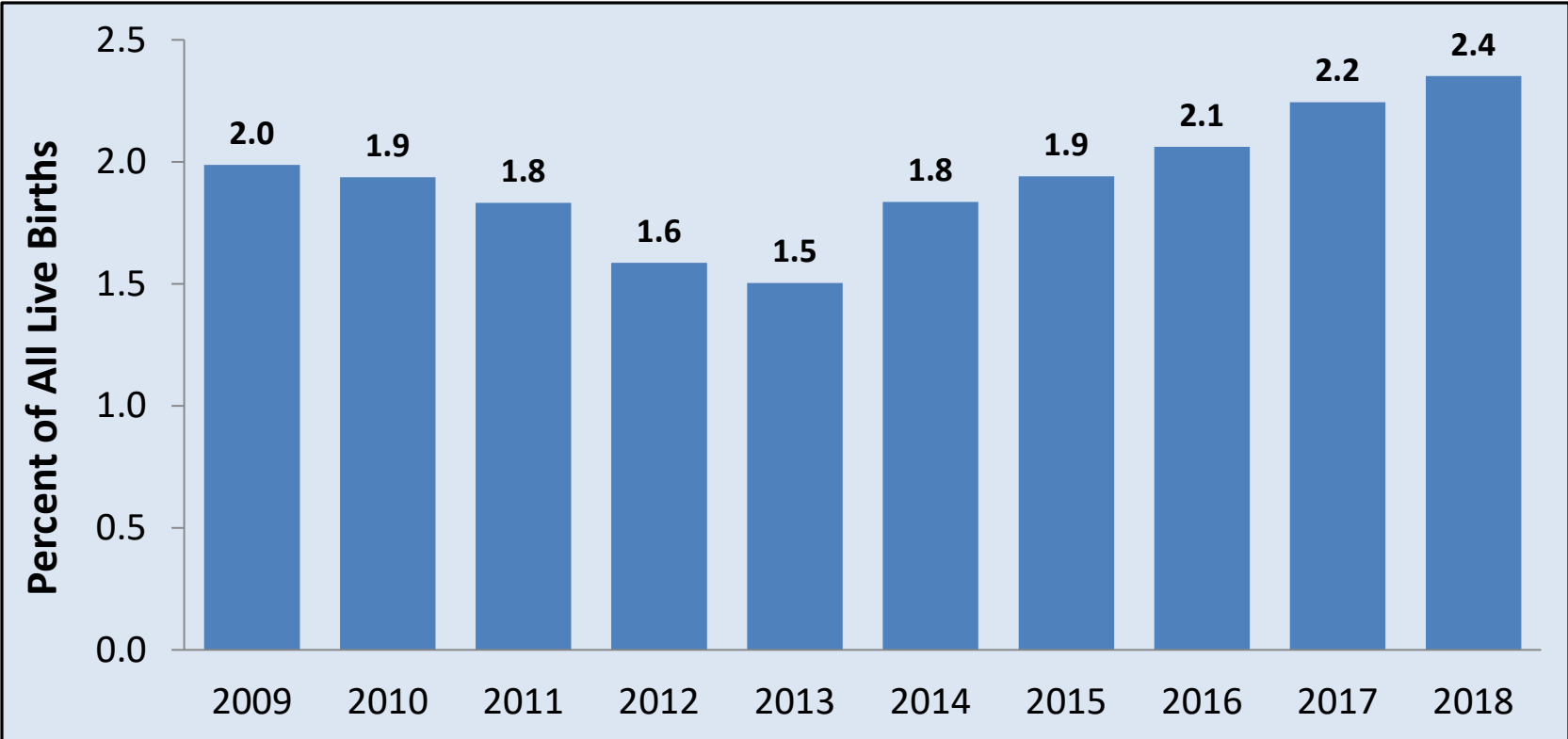


PERCENT OF BIRTHS WITH ADEQUATE PRENATAL CARE¹ ALABAMA, 2009-2018

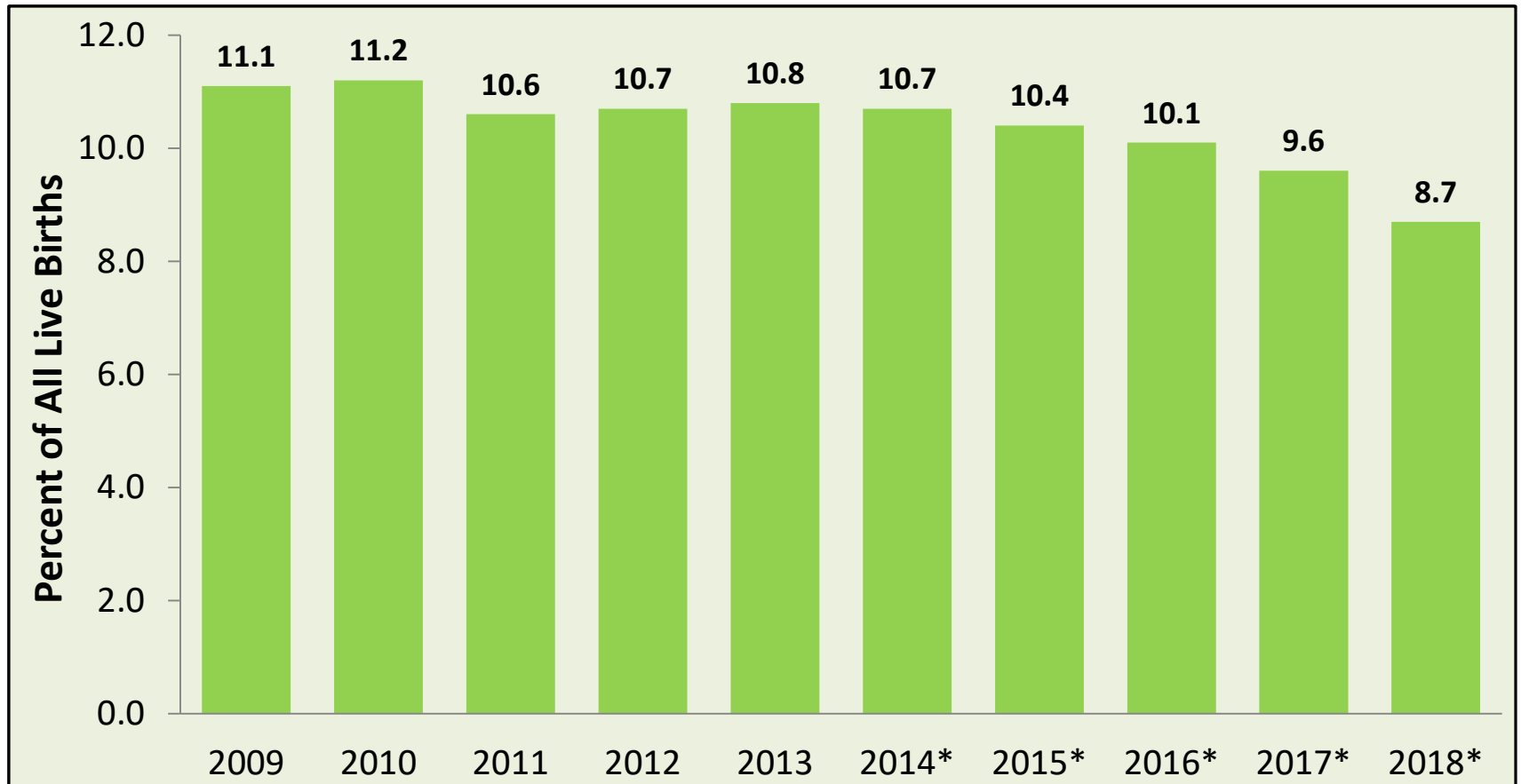

PERCENT OF BIRTHS WITH NO PRENATAL CARE ALABAMA, 2009-2018

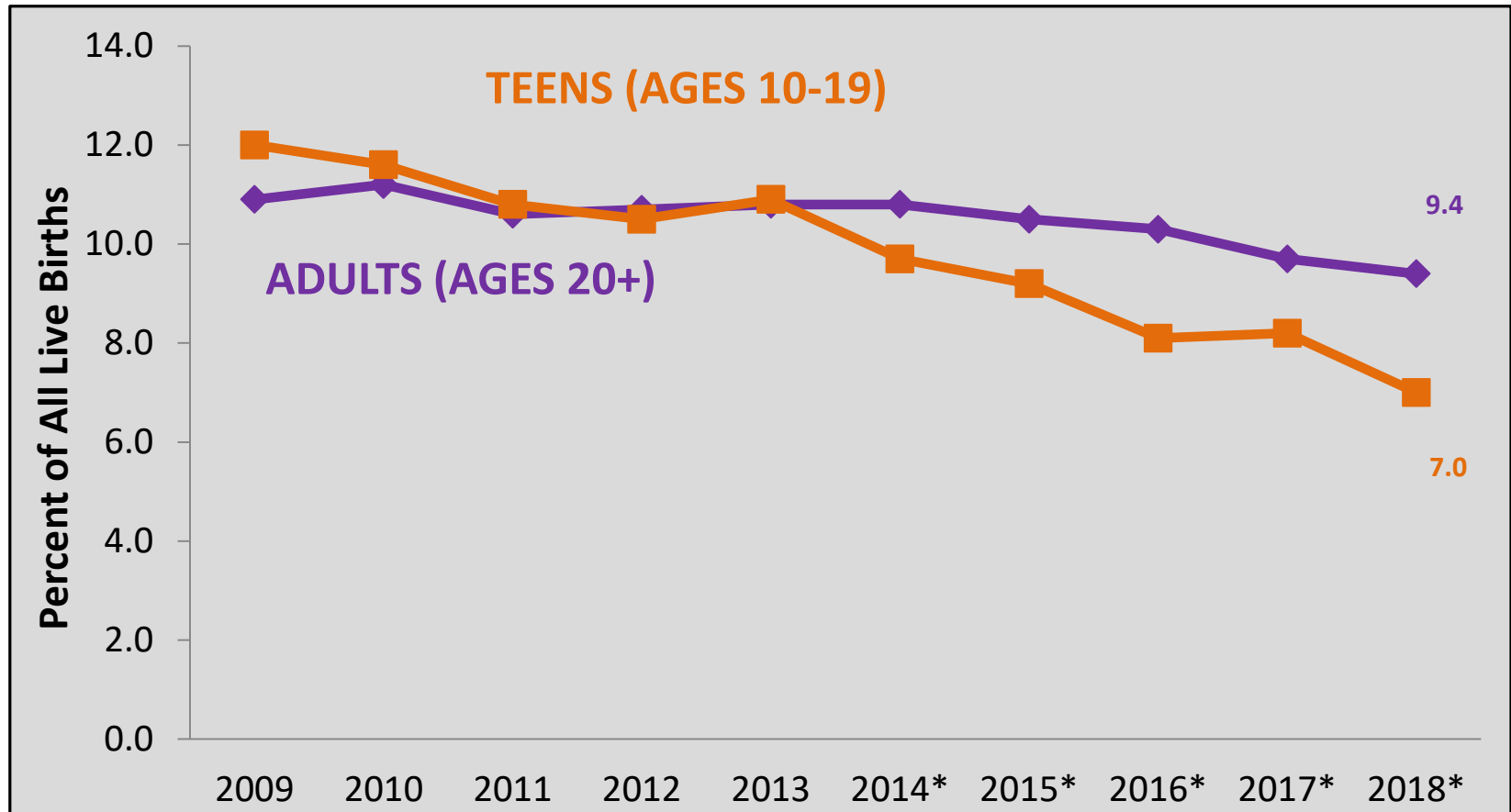


PERCENT OF BIRTHS WITH MATERNAL SMOKING ALABAMA, 2009-2018

LEADING CAUSES OF INFANT DEATHS ALABAMA, 2018

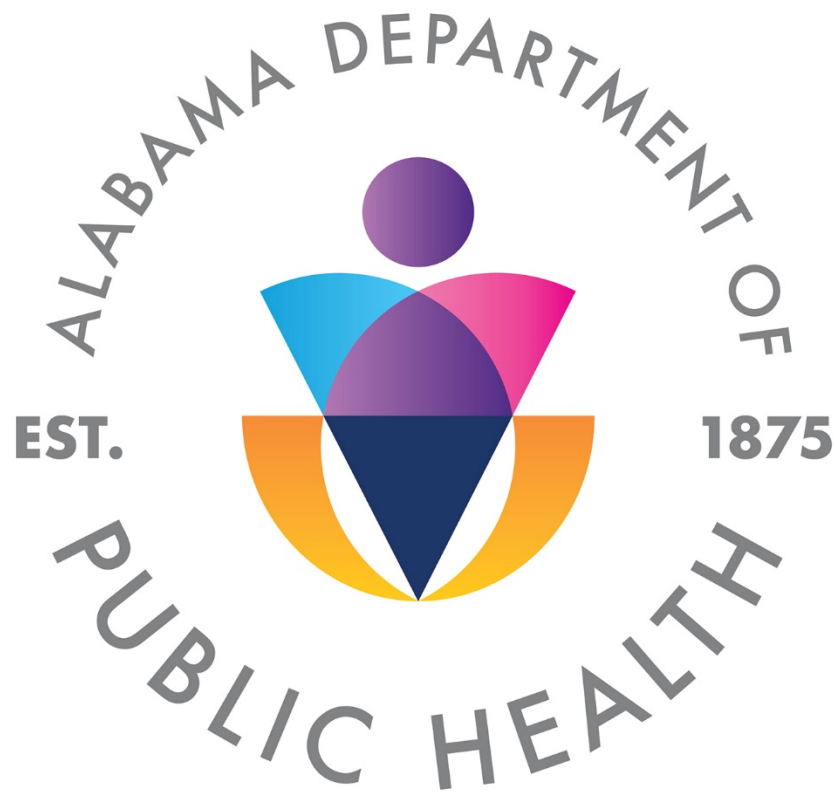
- Top four leading causes of infant deaths
 - Congenital malformations, deformations and chromosomal abnormalities (Q00-Q99)
 - Disorders related to short gestation and low birth weight, not elsewhere classified (P07)
 - Sudden infant death syndrome (R95)
 - Bacterial sepsis of newborn (P36)
- Four leading causes accounted for 50% of infant deaths.
- Top two leading causes of infant deaths were same for US in 2017 and accounted for 39.3% (in AL) and 37.3% (in US) of infant deaths.
