The Alabama Rural Medical Service Awards (ARMSA) incentivize family medicine, internal medicine, pediatric medicine, and Med/ Ped physicians to practice in rural, medically underserved areas in Alabama, ARMSA offers \$50,000 a year for primary care physicians (PCP), with a 3-year maximum award period. The award is a service loan that is payable by years of service.

REQUIREMENTS:

- The PCP must practice full-time ambulatory primary care medicine in an ARMSA-eligible service area.
- The PCP must not have practiced in the rural area within the past 3 years.
- An annual renewable agreement must be signed with the Alabama Department of Public Health.
