CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION TREATMENT GUIDELINES

Chlamydia: Azithromycin 1 g PO in a single dose or Doxycycline 100 mg PO twice a day for 7 days

Gonorrhea: Ceftriaxone 250 mg IM in a single dose PLUS Azithromycin 1 g PO in a single dose **OR**
Ceftriaxone 250 mg IM in a single dose PLUS Doxycycline 100 mg PO twice a day for 7 days
If Ceftriaxone is not available: Cefixime 400mg orally in a single dose PLUS Azithromycin 1 g PO in a single dose

Syphilis: Early Syphilis Cases – Bicillin 24 MU IM in a single dose

Late Syphilis Cases: Bicillin 24 MU IM weekly for three consecutive weeks

Neuro Syphilis: Aqueous crystalline penicillin G 18-24 MU per day, divided into 3-4 MU IV every 4 hours or continuous infusion for 10-14 days

Trichomoniasis: Metronidazole 2 g PO in a single dose **OR**
Tinidazole 2 g PO in a single dose
