On October 1, 2016, approximately two-thirds of all Medicaid recipients will get most of their health care through a Regional Care Organization. Physicians, hospitals and clinics wishing to serve these recipients will need to contract with one or more RCOs in order to be paid for this care. As a unique provider group, RHCs need to prepare for this important change by understanding how this program will impact their clinical, billing and administrative operations. In this program, Medicaid will provide an update on the transition to managed care and also discuss how care coordination will be used to improve health outcomes and ensure quality care for the approximately 650,000 recipients expected to participate in the program.
