AN UPDATE ON CERVICAL CANCER SCREENING AND PREVENTION IN ALABAMA

Cervical cancer is one of the most common cancers found in women worldwide. It is curable when found in the earliest stages and preventive vaccines are now available. Yet, the cervical cancer mortality rate in Alabama is significantly higher than the U.S. rate (3.0 versus 2.4 per 100,000). In 2015, the American Cancer Society estimates that 230 women in Alabama will develop cervical cancer. This program will highlight the benefits of routine cervical cancer screening, including published guidelines that should be followed. Program faculty will discuss why routine HPV/Pap co-testing is more effective than Pap testing alone, follow up after an abnormal screening and HPV vaccinations in early adolescence.
