The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention estimates over one million people are living with AIDS in the United States. Approximately 40,000 new cases are diagnosed each year and surprisingly, a quarter do not know they're infected. Family Planning clinics are uniquely suited to help clients understand their HIV status because it provides a setting where they can talk openly about their sexual activity. The CDC is recommending new strategies to make HIV testing a routine part of medical care. As family planning providers, it's crucial we offer these tests to diagnose and treat infections earlier rather than later.
