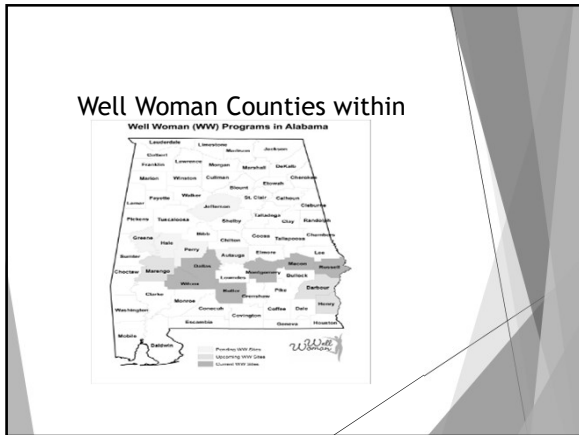


What is Well Woman?

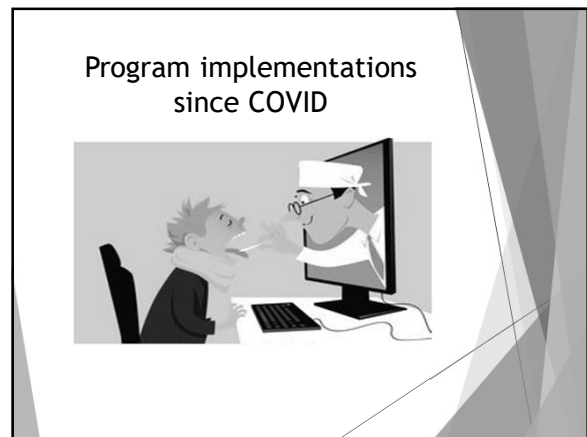
- ❑ **Well Woman** -A program that offers preventative health screenings to women ages 15-55
- ❑ **Mission:** To promote healthy living, prevention, and early detection of disease, to increase quality of life for women 15 - 55 years of age in Alabama
- ❑ **Goals:** Enhance access to healthcare for women in county health departments; Provide preconception and interconception care counseling; Provide risk assessment and behavior modification to prevent and/or manage chronic disease and Reduce maternal & infant morbidity and mortality



- Components of a Well Woman visit**
-
- 1) Health History
 - 2) Clinical Assessment
 - 3) Physical Exam
 - 4) Risk Assessment and Reduction Counseling: Healthy Life Plan
 - 5) Referral for Community Support Services and Follow-up

Enrollment and Demographics

- Current show rates: 50% rate in each county
- 479 clients enrolled in 2019 in all 6 counties
- 371 clients enrolled in 2020 in all 6 counties
- Average age of participants- 35 yrs. old
- 95% of participants African-American women
- 3% of participants are Caucasian women
- 2% of participants are Hispanic women
