## A PERSONALIZED APPROACH TO PEDIATRIC ASTHMA MANAGEMENT

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Asthma is the most common childhood disease, accounting for more days lost from school for children, and days lost from work for parents than any other diagnosis. Much is known about how to manage pediatric asthma so that children can achieve good control of symptoms and lead active, health lives. However, in some situations, a standardized approach may not be successful, and more effort is needed to achieve partnership between families and providers. Opening a dialogue regarding individual circumstances can result in an individualized plan to help achieve optimal control of asthma symptoms. This program will review basic asthma management, as well as factors to consider when a standardized approach is not successful, and review several examples of how to partner with families in designing an individualized plan for success.


