# 2009 Breast and Cervical Cancer Prevention & Treatment Act Fact Sheet

## **Alabama Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program (ABCCEDP)**

- Provides free breast and cervical cancer screening services to <u>eligible</u> women who are enrolled in the program by a contracted healthcare provider.
- There are over 400 contracted providers which include primary care providers, surgeons, hospitals, radiologists, laboratories and others.
- Free services include a Pap smear, pelvic exam, clinical breast exam, mammogram, and diagnostic services if indicated.

# **ABCCEDP Eligibility Criteria**

- Female
- Income at or below 200% of the poverty level
- No insurance or underinsured. *Underinsured is insurance that does not cover cancer screening (i.e. mammograms) or has a high deductible that the woman is unable to pay.*
- Age criteria apply

## **2009** Breast and Cervical Cancer Prevention and Treatment Act (HB 147)

- Formerly the Alabama Breast and Cervical Cancer Prevention and Treatment Act of 2000
- A woman <u>enrolled</u> in ABCCEDP diagnosed with breast or cervical cancer is eligible for treatment through Medicaid. Medicaid will only provide treatment for documented citizens and residents of Alabama.
- Effective July 1, 2009, a woman <u>not enrolled</u> in ABCCEDP, who meets ABCCEDP eligibility criteria, diagnosed with breast and cervical cancer is eligible for treatment through Medicaid. Medicaid will only provide treatment for documented citizens and residents of Alabama.
- A woman not enrolled in the program must contact ABCCEDP <u>before treatment is initiated</u>. The program will then verify the eligibility criteria, diagnosis and citizenship and refer the woman to Medicaid.
- A breast or cervical cancer diagnosis must be obtained through breast biopsy or biopsy with colposcopy.
