



Sex Trafficking – Glossary of Terms

5-0 (Five Oh): police

Around the World: oral stimulation of anus and genitals

Back Door: anus

Bag Up: to be arrested by the police

Bare Back: sexual intercourse without the use of a condom

Blade: a street where prostitutes work; also referred to as the track

Bottom/Bottom Bitch: the person in the stable who has been with pimp the longest or who is the most trusted. She is usually the recruiter for the pimp and has the task of training new girls, supervising the other girls, reporting rule violations and helping the pimp inflict punishment on the violators

Branding: when a pimp tattoos his name on the victim

Bread: money; also may mean vagina

Break yourself: a pimp's order to a prostitute to turn over all of her earnings

Campaign: the cars, jewels, furs, shoes, and tailor-made clothes a pimp displays to get elected by the prostitutes

Carpet Ho: a prostitute who primarily works hotels or casinos

Catcher: usually younger "wannabe pimps" who watch those engaged in prostitution on "the track" to make sure they are following the pimp's orders.

Choose Up: to choose another pimp

Circuit: when someone works the circuit, her pimp takes her from city to city, or "track to track"; the person will work a certain track until that person stops making money, or the "heat is turned up" (police begin to pay too much attention to that person).

Daddy: what pimps require the people they prostitute to call them. Also how many pimps refer to themselves.

Date: a trick or John; the customer

Donation: euphemism for fee

Facial: ejaculation on the face

Finesse Pimp: pimp who prides himself on controlling others primarily through psychological manipulation. AKA Passion Pimp

Freelance: a person engaged in prostitution who works inside a casino or hotel, and approaches clients while they are drinking and/or gambling. NOTE: This has nothing to do with whether the person engaged in prostitution has a pimp.

Full Service: intercourse to completion (with condom)

The Game: pimp and prostitution subculture. Anyone involved in prostitution is said to be "in the game."

GFE: Girlfriend Experience. A type of session providing aspects of social and physical interaction beyond sex.

To Ghost Someone: to avoid someone, disappear

Gorilla Ho: prostitute who assists the pimp in controlling the pimp's stable by using violence

Gorilla Pimp: pimp who controls his prostitutes through violence

Green: inexperienced in the game; amateur

Greek: anal sex

Half n' Half: an act of prostitution in which there is both oral and vaginal sex

Hobbyist: term Johns use to refer to themselves

House Mom: strip club employee who organizes, hires and keeps track of the women who dance at the club talking about "donations for time and companionship"

In-call: a date that takes place at the escort's place of residence or in a hotel room arranged by the escort





Ism: optimal pimping; also refers to chronic marijuana

John: also trick, lick- a client of prostitution

Lick: a john or a trick; also refers to a burglary or a robbery

The Life: the experience of being used in prostitution. May involve heavy drug and alcohol use, violence and other crimes.

Lifestyle Party: a swingers party where participants exchange sexual partners

Meat Grinder: a prostitute who sees many clients in quick succession

Monger: term johns use to refer to themselves

Out-Call: the act takes place at the customer's place or residence or in a hotel room that the customer purchased.

Out of Pocket: when the prostitute breaks the "rules", e.g. arguing, making eye contact with another pimp, or try to run off another prostitute in the stable

Party: the act of prostitution. A prostitute may ask a client if he wants to "party".

Peel a Trick: when a prostituted person steals something from his/her client, such as money, checkbooks or credit cards. May be part of a group or sell items to a group who "hang paper" or engage in identity theft.

Pimp Party: when several pimps unite for the purpose of abusing a prostituted person for being disrespectful, trying to leave the game, or reporting the pimp to the police.

The pimps usually gang rape the prostituted person, beating her, urinating and/or defecating on her, and other forms of abuses.

Pimp Stick: a steel whip made out of coat hanger wire. May be heated on a stove to burn as well as cut. Other items, such as appliance cords, towel bars, curtain rods and cigarettes, may also be used.

Rent Boy: young, gay, male prostitute

Roll a Trick: robbing a trick with force by prostituted person, the pimp, or his associates.

Roses: money; often used in online ads

Shone: sexually overeager; a "slut"

Skittles: money; used similarly to "roses"

Snow Bunny: white female involved in prostitution

Square: trying to go straight and get out of the life; someone in law enforcement or who doesn't understand "the game"

Stable: the group of women and girls under a pimp's control

Sweating or Sweatin' a Bitch: trying to persuade, convince, or harass a prostitute into leaving her old pimp

Tennis Shoe Pimp: a pimp who is new to the game (whose shoes are still white)

Track: a street where prostitutes work; also referred to as a blade

Trap: money a pimp gets from a prostitute; also may refer to a drug hole

Trick: a customer or a date

Whip: a flashy car, part of a pimp's campaign

Wifey: a fellow prostitute with the same pimp
