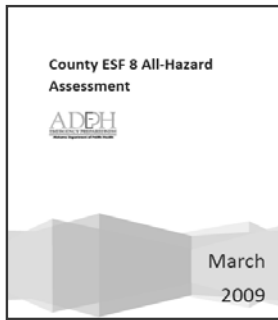

AIMS: Alabama Incident Management System
 The Alabama Incident Management System (AIMS) is a computer software program that allows the ADPH to allocate resources, create teams, schedule events, medical needs database, and resource needs request through states of Alabama. In an emergency situation across that triggers the sending up of the State Incident Command System (SICS), a handbook specific can be used to login to the AIMS website and enter requested resource data.

ADPH, in cooperation with the Governor's Office and Alabama Emergency Management Agency (AEMA), will use this data to meet healthcare organizations and coordinate the emergency medical response. 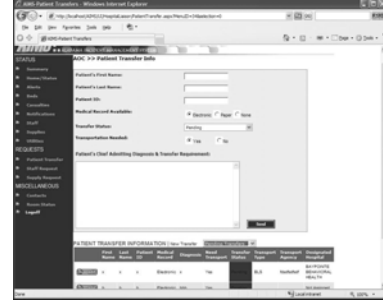
- Data is utilized during emergencies

ALERT: Alabama Emergency Response Technology

- Internet-based Emergency Alert Notification System
- Secure system
- Will replace the health alert network (HAN) for Alabama
- Notifies first responders, ADPH staff, and EP team when emergencies occur
