Identify Threats: Security Survey

Analyze Overall Environment

Risk Factors

- Contact with the public
- Exchange of money
- Delivery of services or goods
- Having a mobile workplace
- Working with unstable or volatile persons in healthcare or social services

Risk Factors

- Working alone or in small numbers
- Working late at night or during early morning hours
- Working in high crime areas
- Guarding valuable property or possessions
- Working in community-based settings

Analyze Overall Environment

- Residential / business community
- Traffic
 - -Walking / vehicle
- Local police stations
- Neighbors

Evaluate Outside Threats

Exterior Barriers

- What stops potential threats?
- What do I have and what can I get?
