



Why the Need for Action in Alabama?

- Growth in AL (% 3rd in Nation)
- · 400- 2,500% growth in 13+ counties
- Few existing quantitative/qualitative studies
- · % unaccompanied males
- Few agencies providing outreach & training clinicians
