

## **Serious Infectious Disease Screening**

## **Emergency Department screening criteria for patient isolation/testing are likely to be:**

1. International travel to <u>or</u> contact with someone who is ill and traveled to a country that is currently experiencing or is at risk for a communicable disease outbreak of urgent public health concern per <a href="https://wwwnc.cdc.gov/travel/notices">https://wwwnc.cdc.gov/travel/notices</a>; <u>or</u> healthcare worker with a recent exposure to a potential communicable disease of urgent public health concern; <u>or</u> anyone who reports being part of a cluster of two or more persons with a similar febrile, respiratory illness.

## **AND**

2. Experience one or more of these symptoms: fever, headache, cough, trouble breathing, diarrhea, rash, joint aches, and vomiting.

<u>If both criteria are met</u>, then the patient should be moved to a private room with a bathroom or Airborne Isolation Infection Room (AIIR) and STANDARD, CONTACT, and DROPLET precautions followed during further assessment.
