Updates

EMS for Children Program Update –

The EMSC National Resource Center is now the EMSC Innovation and Improvement Center. It will be housed at Baylor College of Medicine and Texas Children's Hospital in Houston.

There will be no competitive grant application process this year.

There will be no grantee meeting this year.

EMS Rules Change – Mrs. Hert and Dr. Klasner are working with the OEMS administration to add all components of the inter-facility transfer guidelines to the rules document. All but three components are already included. This will allow the program to meet Performance Measure 76. An

exemption request will be sent to HRSA when the rules document is approved by the State Committee on Public Health.

EMSC day update – Mrs. Hert mailed out 4348 cards to the schools that expressed interest in participating in the project. 2404 cards were received and distributed by the program. 8 cards went to each licensed service in the state. Mrs. Hert will be working on a poster to present at the National Association of State EMS Officials fall meeting in Albuquerque in September.

EMS for Children/EMS webcasts – Mrs. Hert reminded the board that we have access to a studio and can easily put together a webcast if there is a topic or faculty who wants to produce continuing education for EMS personnel.
