

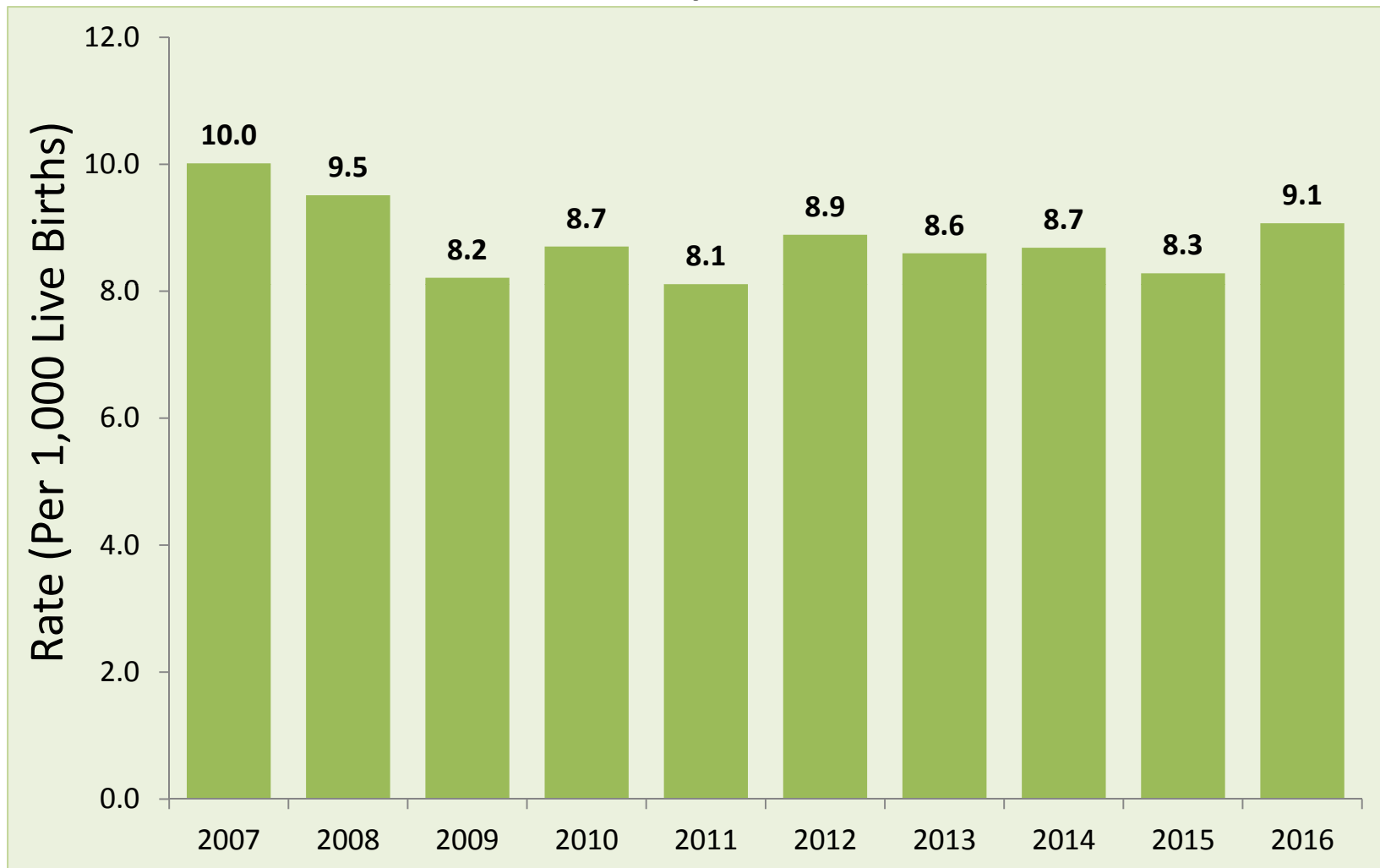

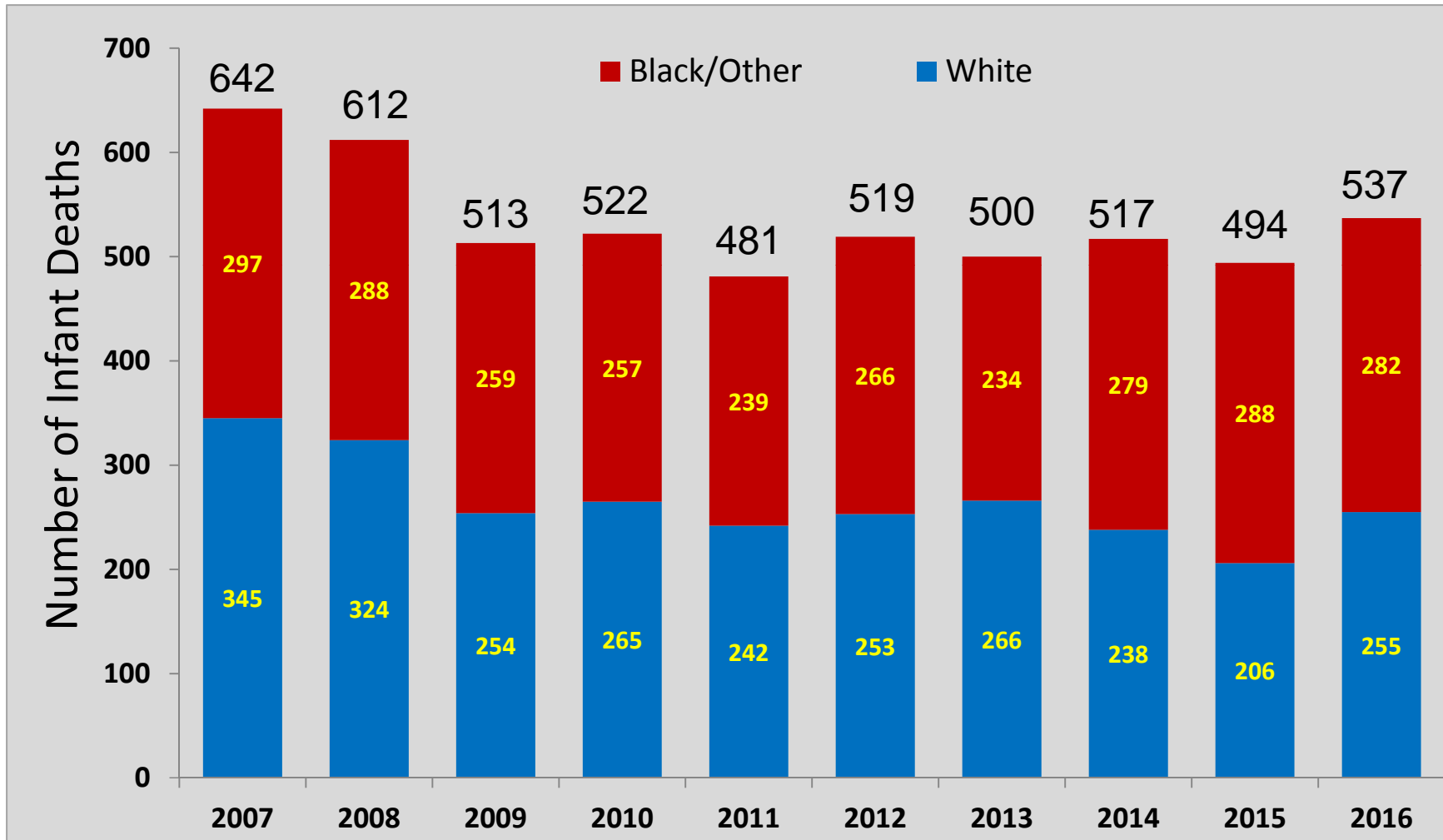

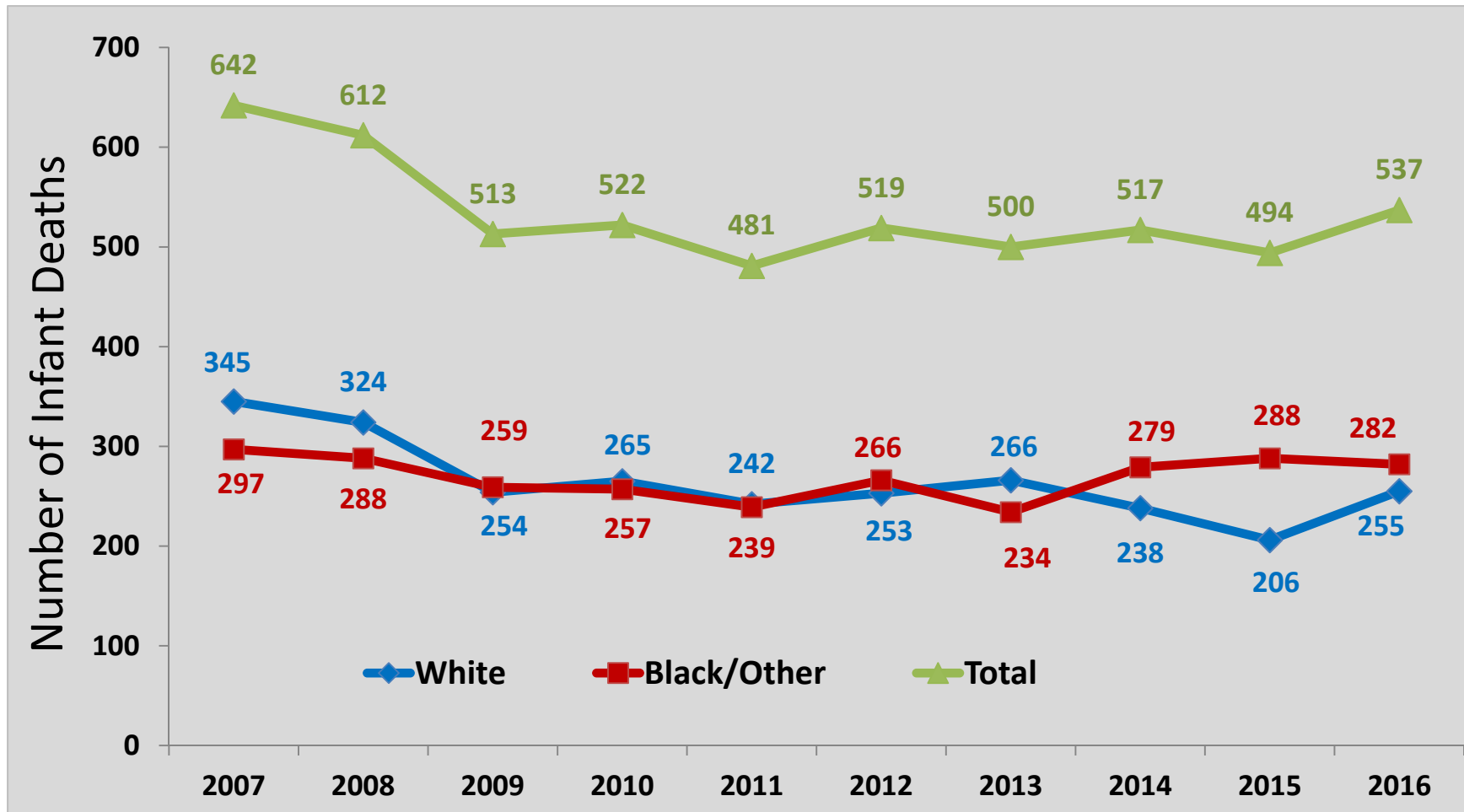
INFANT MORTALITY RATES ALABAMA, 2007-2016



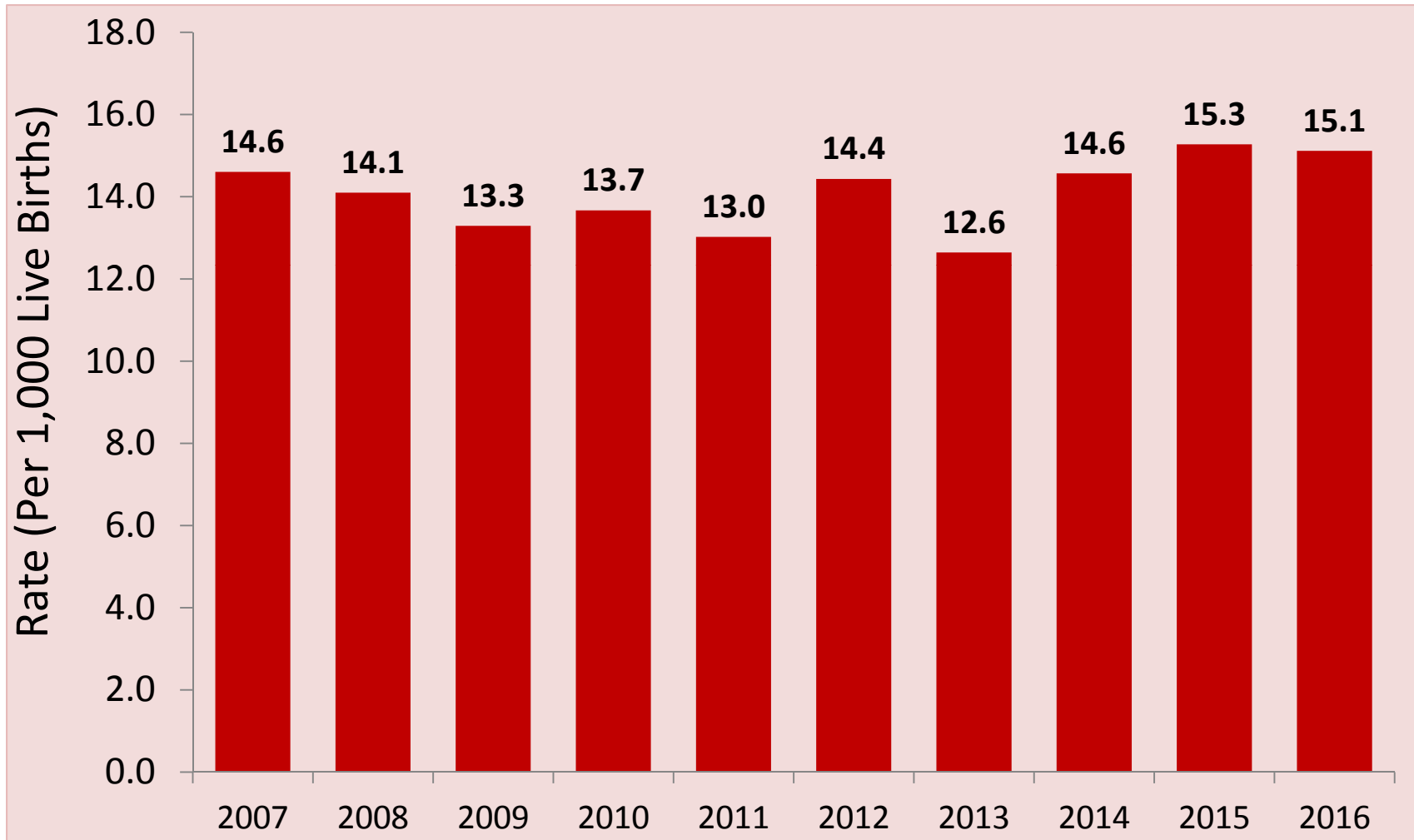
NUMBER OF INFANT DEATHS ALABAMA, 2007-2016



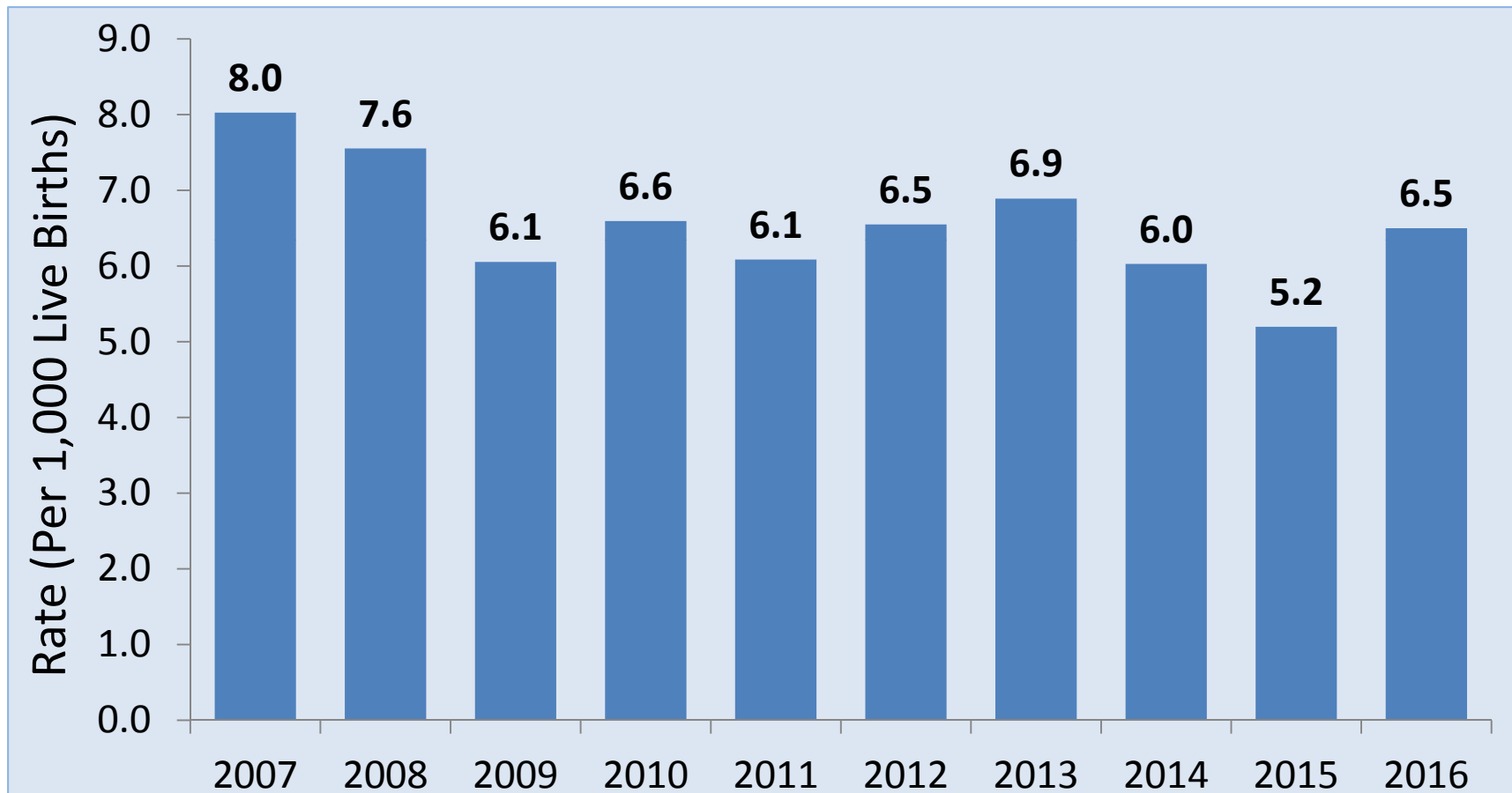

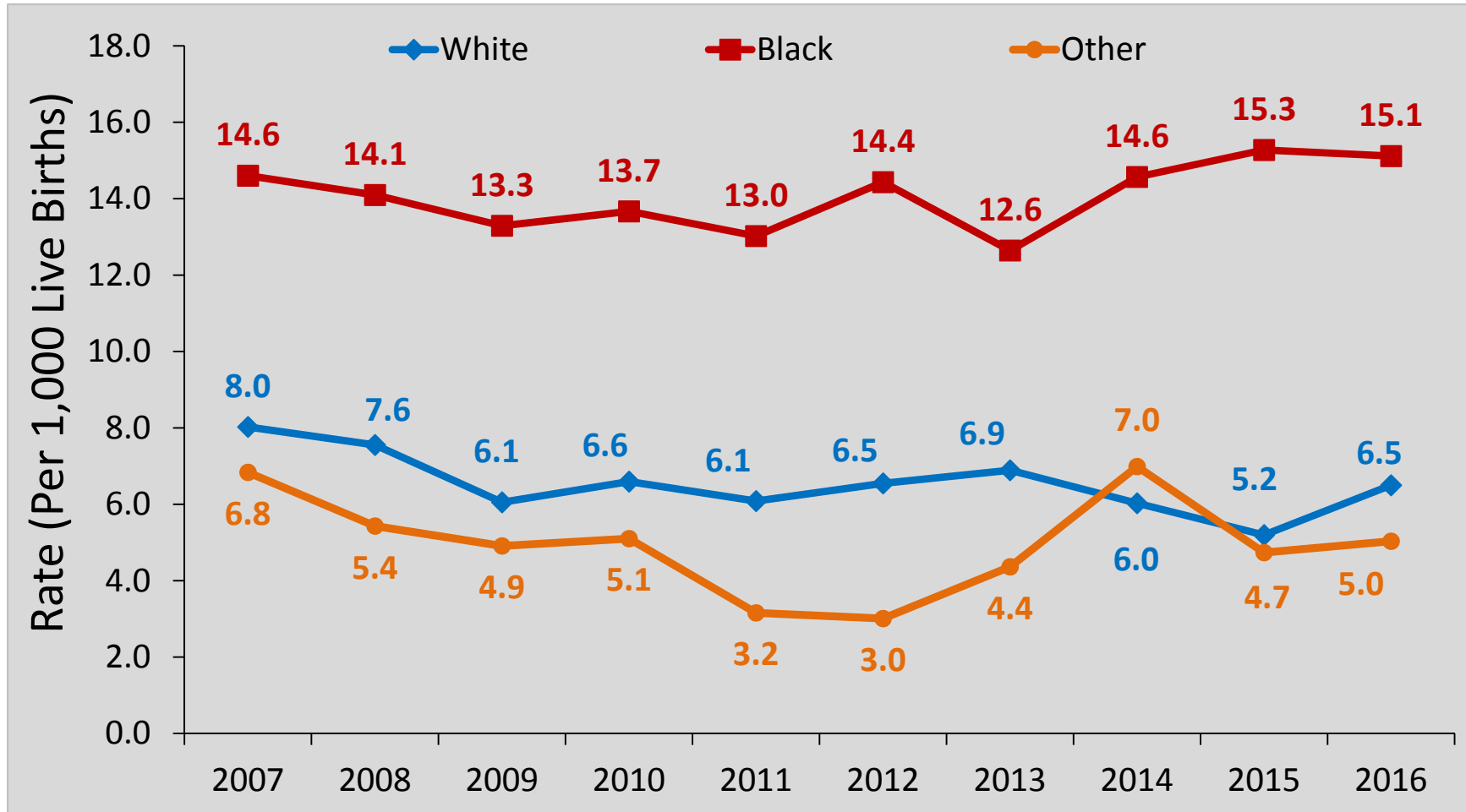
INFANT MORTALITY RATES, BLACK INFANTS ALABAMA, 2007-2016



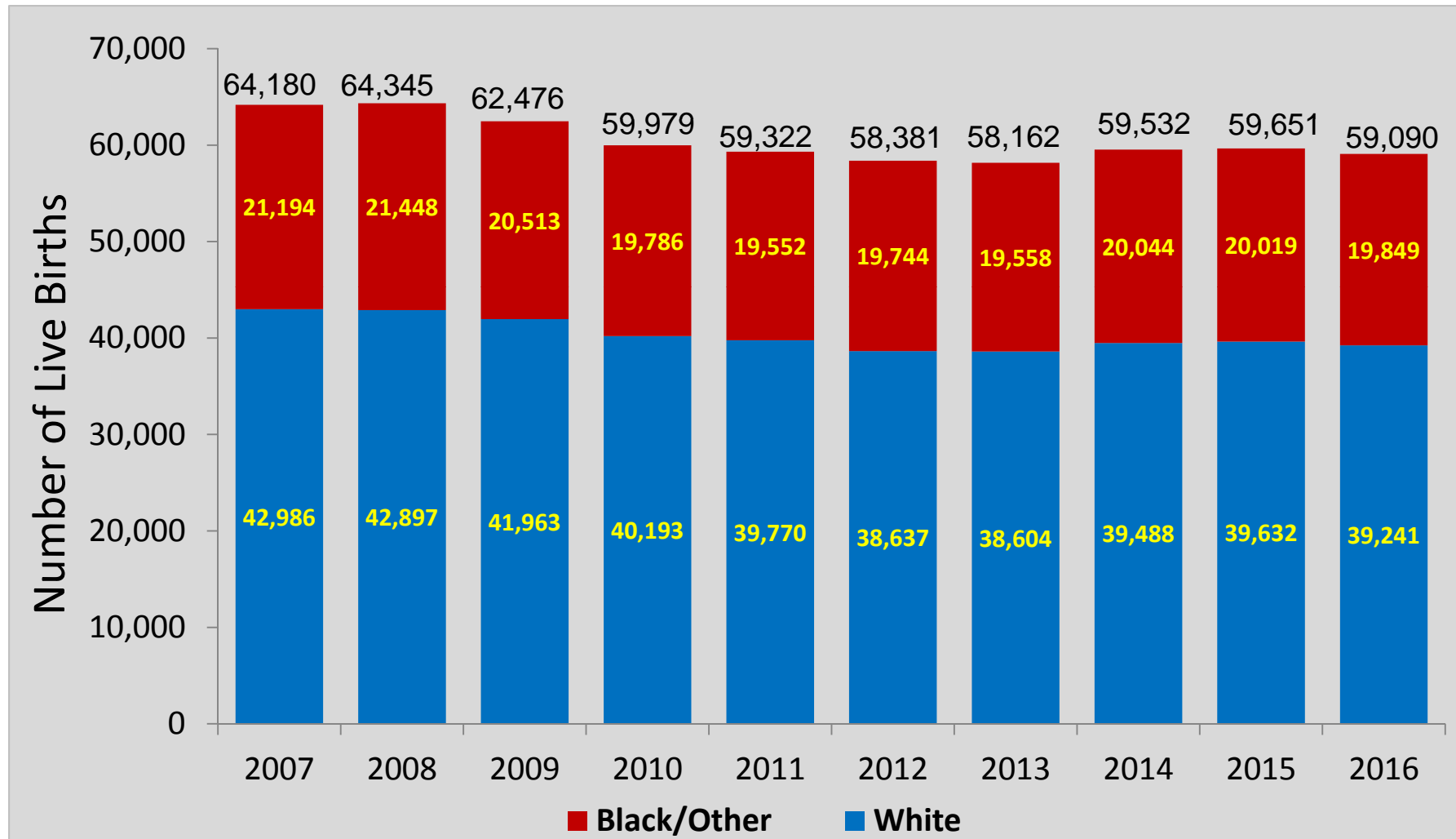

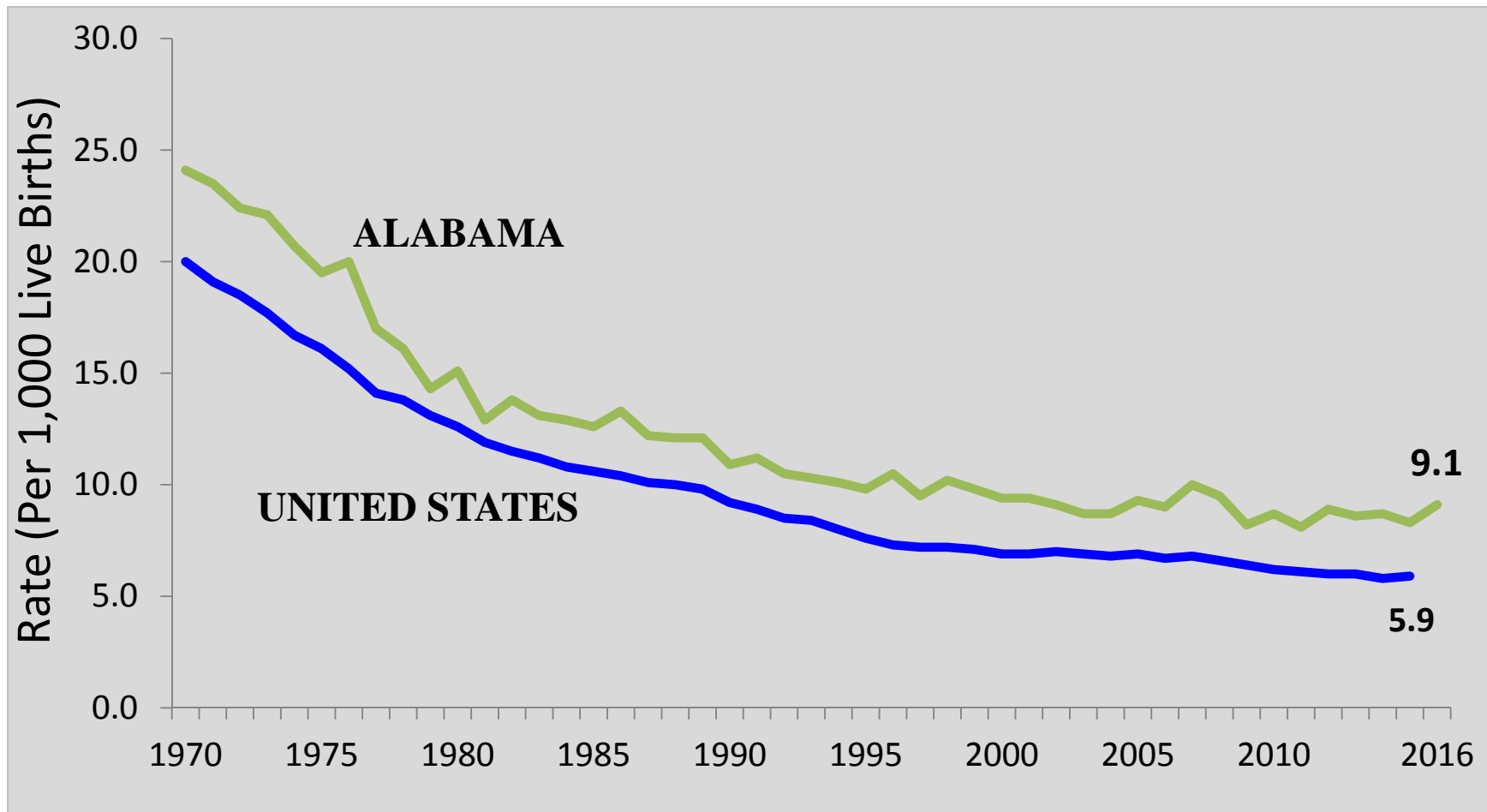

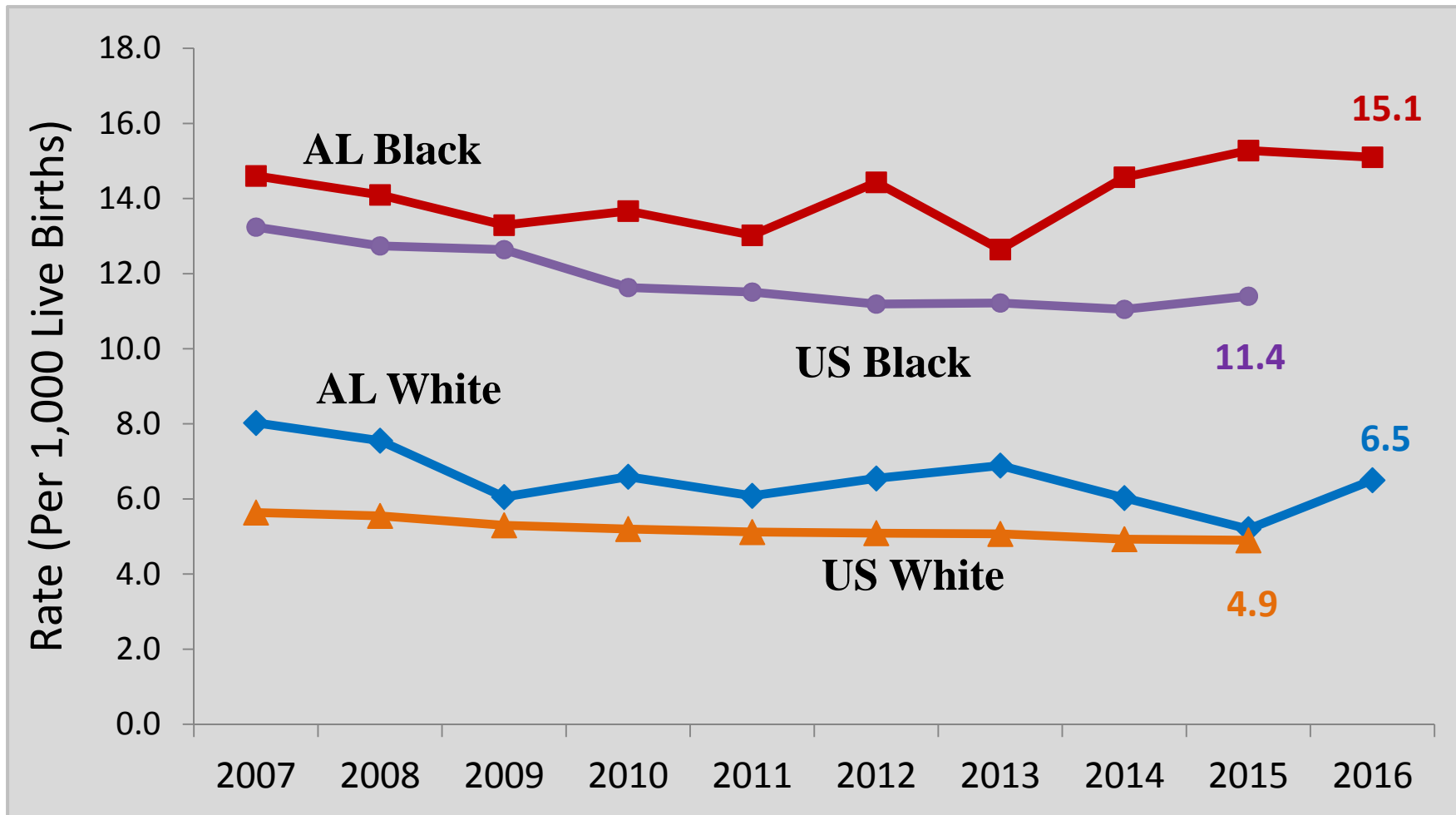


INFANT MORTALITY RATES ALABAMA AND UNITED STATES¹ 1970-2016



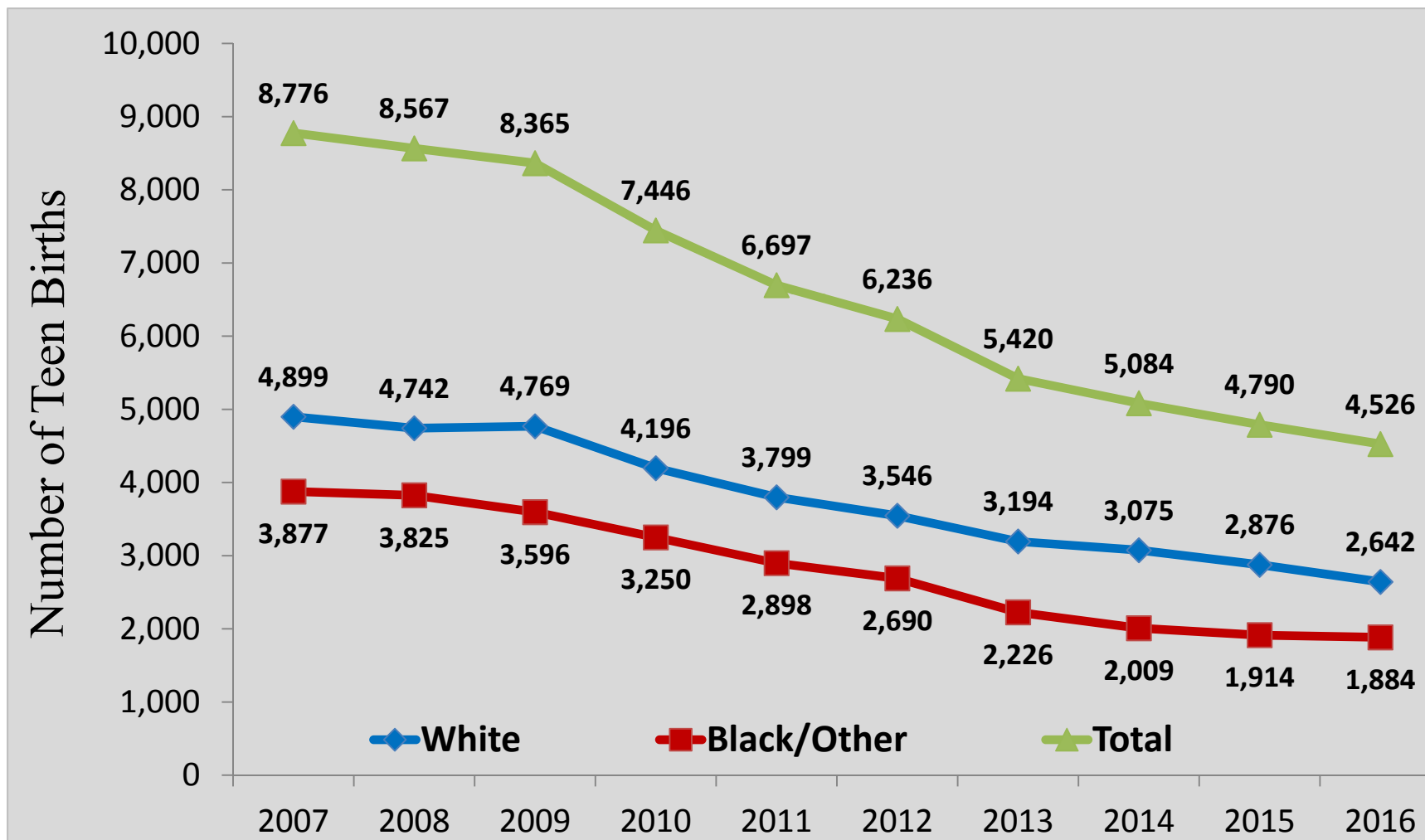

NUMBER OF TEEN BIRTHS (AGES 10-19) ALABAMA, 2007-2016



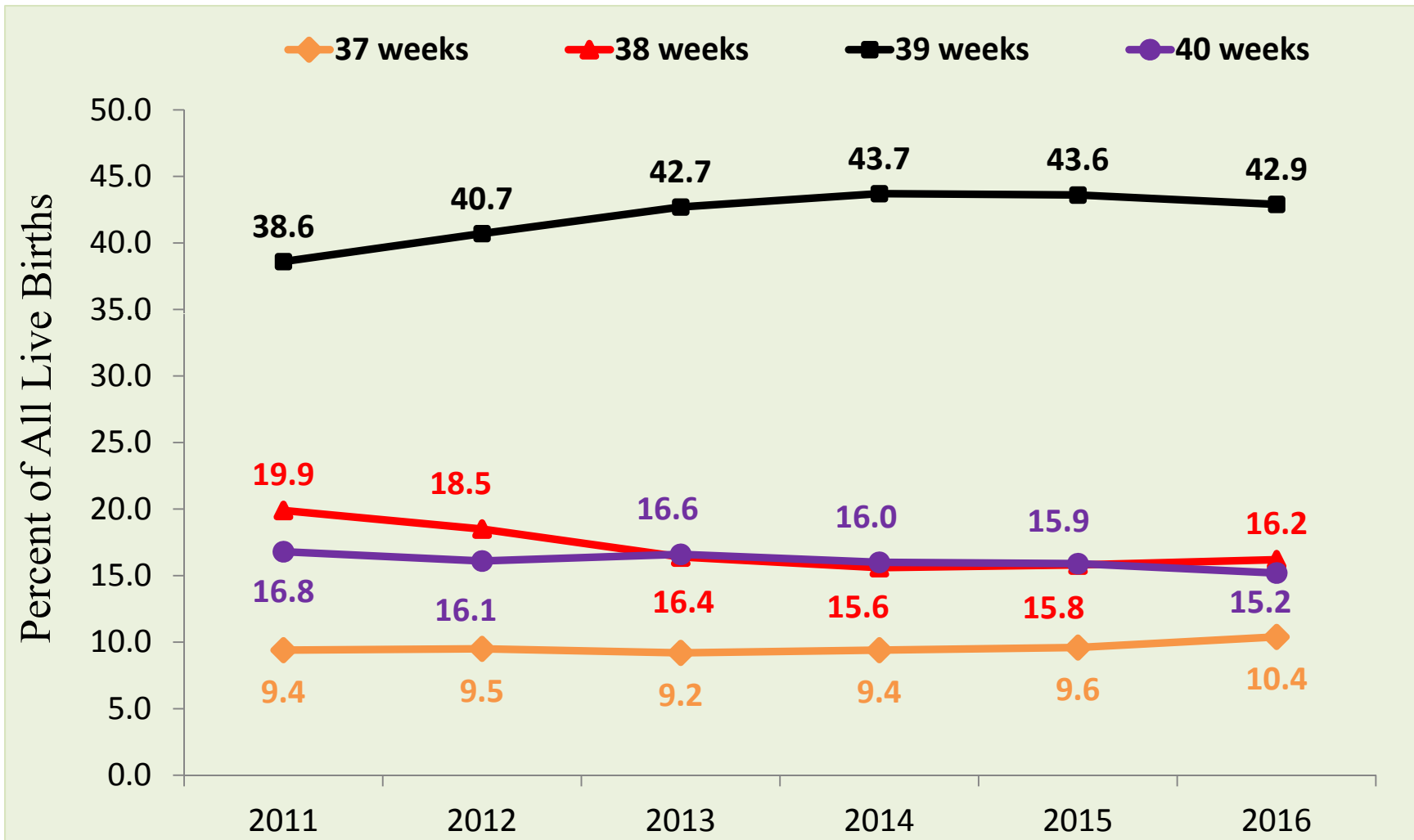
PERCENT OF BIRTHS TO TEENAGERS (AGES 10-19) ALABAMA, 2007-2016



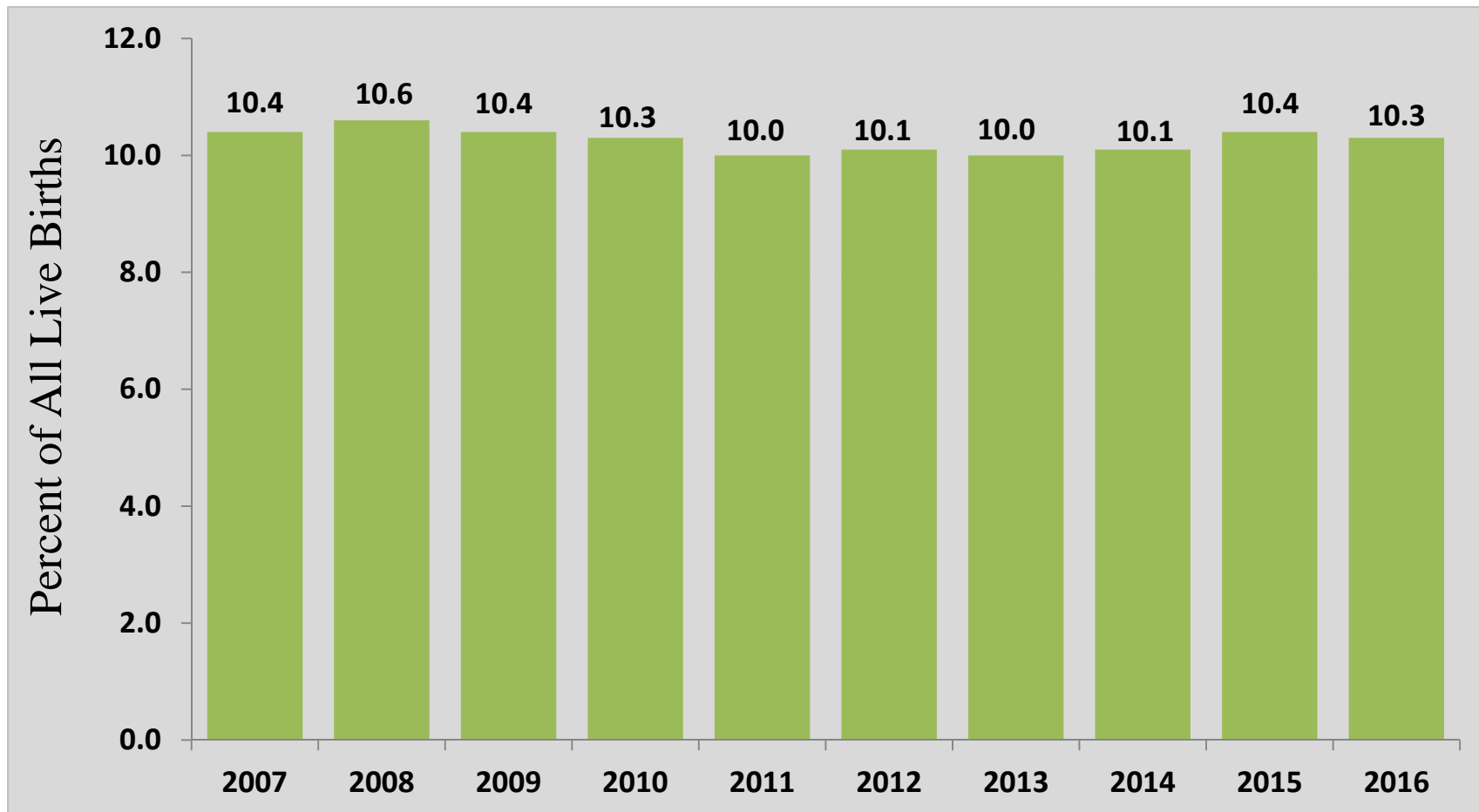
PERCENT OF BIRTHS LESS THAN 37 WEEKS GESTATION, ALABAMA, 2007-2016



PERCENT OF BIRTHS AT 37- 40 WEEKS GESTATION, ALABAMA, 2011-2016

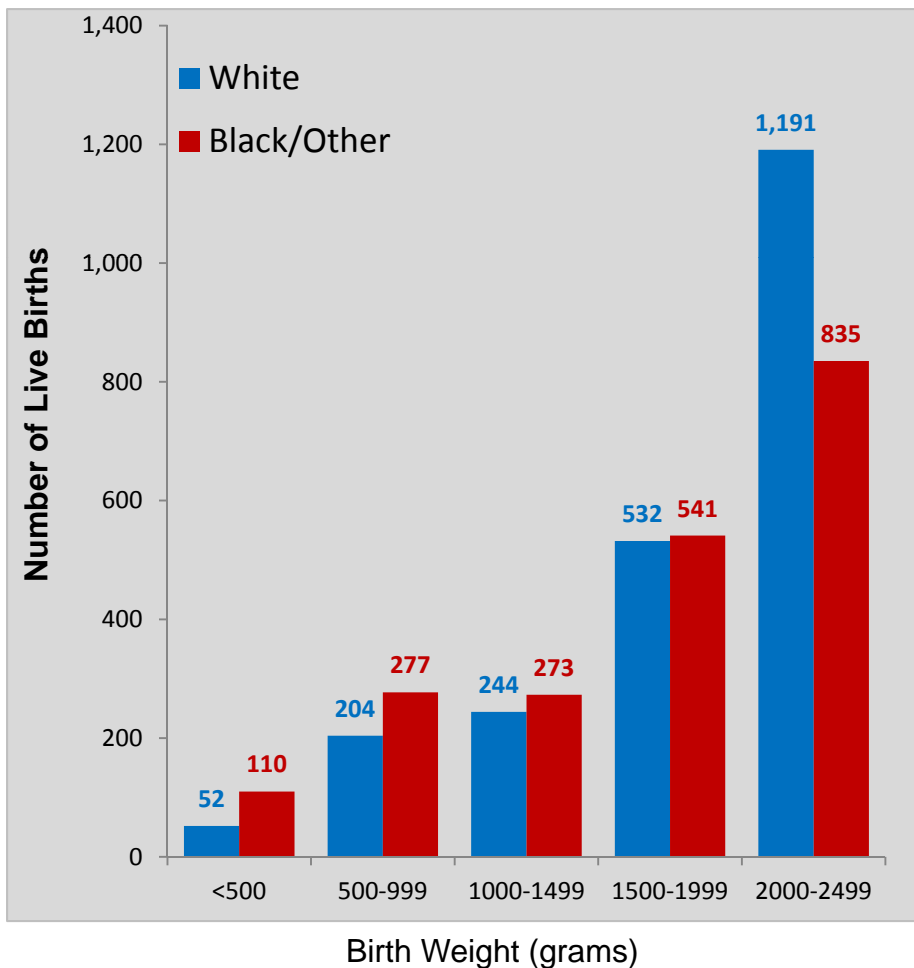


PERCENT OF LOW WEIGHT BIRTHS ALABAMA, 2007-2016

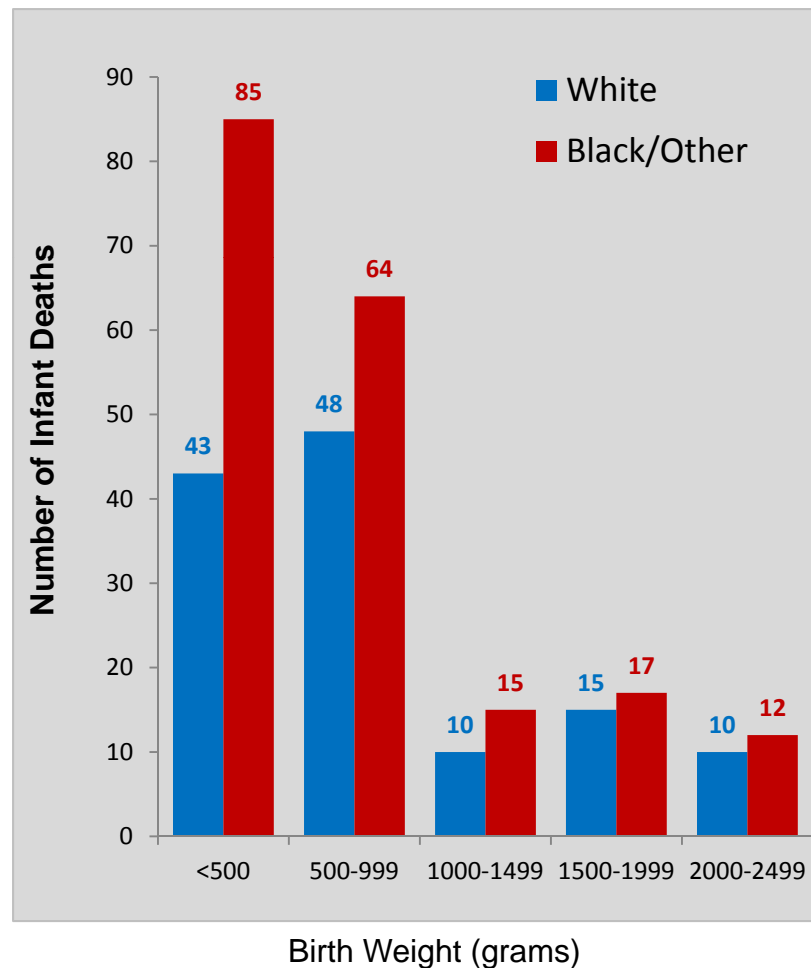

PERCENT OF BIRTHS WITH ADEQUATE PRENATAL CARE¹ ALABAMA, 2007-2016

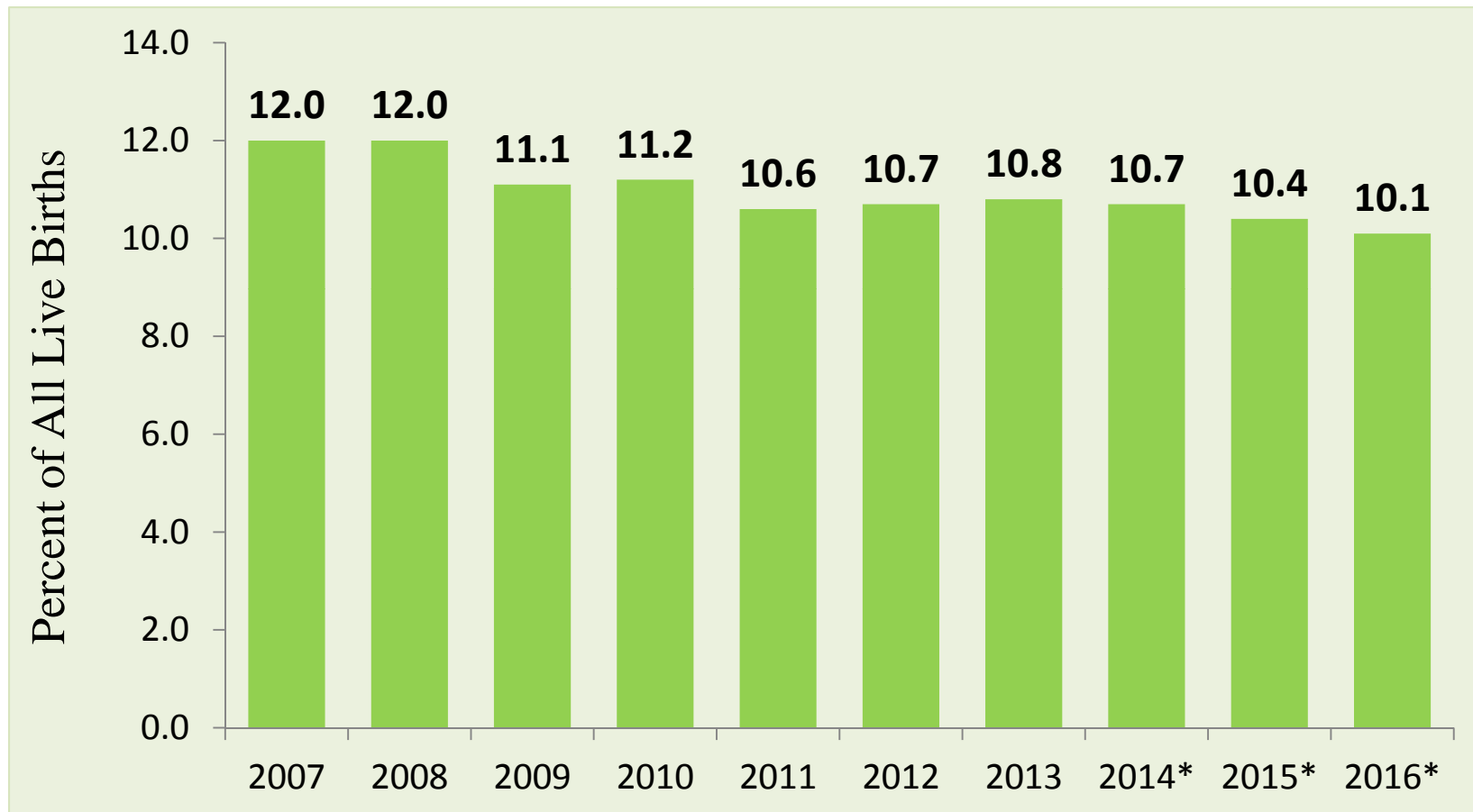

PERCENTAGE OF BIRTHS WITH NO PRENATAL CARE ALABAMA, 2007-2016

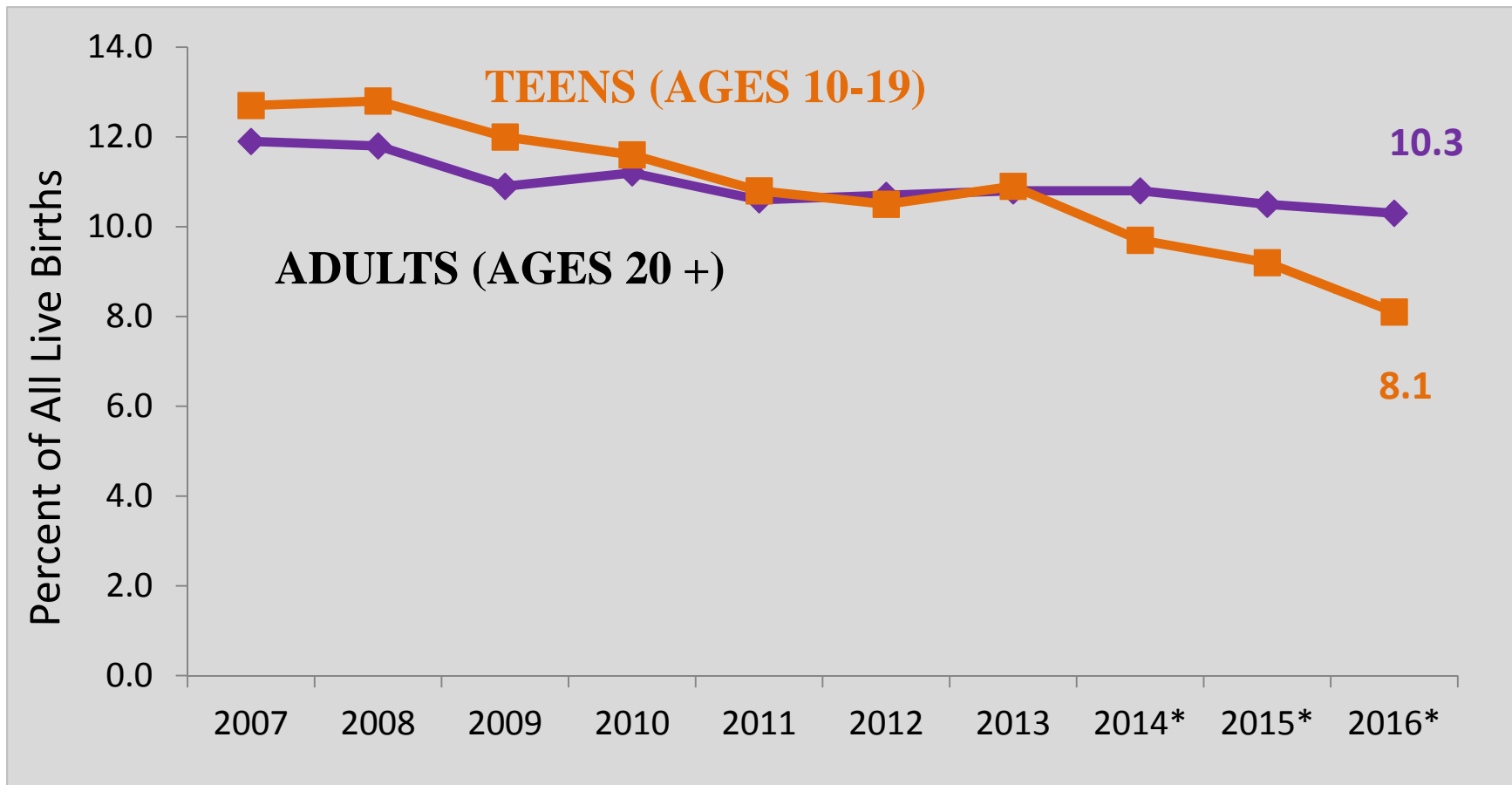


PERCENT OF BIRTHS WITH MATERNAL SMOKING ALABAMA, 2007-2016
