GET INFORMED

GET SCREENED

Cervical cancer screening typically starts at age 21 and is repeated periodically.

GET VACCINATED

The HPV vaccine should be given to:
9-14 year olds - two doses of the vaccine
15-26 year olds - three doses of the vaccine
