

HOW TO APPLY FOR MEDICAID FOR PREGNANT WOMEN

The Alabama Medicaid Maternity Care Program is Designed to ensure every pregnant woman has access to medical care, to lower Alabama's infant mortality rate and improve the health of mothers and infants.

- Even if you do not know about income guidelines, **APPLY FOR MEDICAID**. Your local eligibility worker will help you determine if you qualify.

- For a paper application, call 1-800-362-1504 or visit the Medicaid website at www.medicaid.alabama.gov.
- If you have not been notified about the status of your application within 45 days, contact your eligibility worker.

RECOMMENDED DOCUMENTS TO BRING WITH YOU WHEN YOU APPLY FOR PREGNANCY MEDICAID

(to prevent a delay in processing your application)

- Social Security cards and birth dates of all household members for whom you are applying.
- Birth Certificate or Proof of US Citizenship of all household members for whom you are applying.
- Something with your physical home address (a P.O. Box address is not allowed).

APPLYING ON-LINE

- Go to <https://insurealabama.adph.state.al.us>.
- Click on "Create Your Account!"
- Type in your "Username" and "Password" if you already have an account. If you do not already have an account click on "Create Account". From there, the application should take about 30-45 minutes to complete.
