# Hypertension Clinic Collaboration

- 2006: Diabetes Clinic
- 2007: Samford purchases home in Marion for pharmacy student use
- Today: Samford faculty member and students continue work at HTN Clinic
  - Also work with local physicians and community pharmacy

### **Patient Education Is Key**

- Body Love Radio Show
  - -Wednesday mornings at 8:30
- Hypertension Clinic
  - -Wednesday afternoons 2:00-4:00
- Diabetes Classes
  - Monthly Thursday afternoons2:00-3:30 (Uniontown)

### **Patient Education Is Key**

- Patient Assistance
- Education
  - -Risk factors
  - Medication compliance
  - -Warning signs
  - -Lifestyle changes

### **Patient Education Is Key**

- Screening programs
  - -Blood pressure
  - -Diabetes

### **Hypertension Clinic Format**

- Patient history (new patients)
  - Health status interview, disease states, family history, medications
  - Medication list from local pharmacy\*
- Review past visits and medication list with patient

#### **Hypertension Clinic Format**

- Measurements: weight, BP, HR, BG, waist / hip ratio, BMI, cholesterol
- · Interventions / counseling
  - Weight reduction, diet, exercise, tobacco use, drug therapy/compliance
  - -Prevention of disease complications

### **Hypertension Clinic Format**

Recommendations faxed or taken directly to physician's office

#### **Diabetes Patient Interventions**

- Review blood sugar logs
- Review diet
  - Indicate foods that increase blood sugar the most
- Microfilament foot sensation tests

#### **Diabetes Patient Interventions**

- Self-monitoring of blood glucose
  - -Does patient SMBG?
  - Signs and symptoms of Hypo and Hyperglycemia
    - What should you do?

#### **Diabetes Patient Interventions**

- Counseling on regular physician exams
  - A1C, lipid panel, dilated eye exam, kidneys (microalbumin), influenza and pneumococcal vaccinations

- Community events
  - Childhood obesity parade
- Health screenings
- Home visits
- Church wellness programs

  - Every second Saturday morning

#### **Education Makes a Difference**

- We've seen small decreases in mean weight, systolic blood pressure, and diastolic blood pressure
- CDC statistics show the stroke death rate in Perry County has declined 19.5% in recent years from 190 to 153 per 100,000 people

#### **Education Makes a Difference**

 Education and increased awareness are helping patients to become more diligent in controlling their disease states and risk factors
