Letter from Secretary Ridge to Governors, Sept. 8, 2004

- Coordinate technical assistance to locals;
- Institutionalize the use of the Incident Command System; and
- Provide leadership for tribal and local governments to develop a strategy for statewide NIMS compliance.

- Institutionalize use of Incident Command System;
- Complete NIMS Awareness course IS-700, NIMS: An Introduction;
- Formally recognize NIMS and adopt NIMS principles and policies;

- Establish a NIMS baseline by determining which NIMS requirements have already been met; and
- Establish timeframe and strategy for full NIMS Implementation.
