## Continuing Education Satellite Conferences and Webcasts Alabama Department of Public Health

Beginning February 1, 2013 distance learning conference participants who are not employees, contract employees, or retirees of the Alabama Department of Public Health will pay a fee to receive continuing education certificates.

Disciplines eligible include: nurses, social workers, and paraprofessionals.

There is no charge to register or participate in ADPH conferences via satellite, webcast, or audio bridge.

## **CONTINUING EDUCATION - NURSES AND SOCIAL WORKERS:**

Non-ADPH participants who want to receive continuing education credit must submit \$17.50 (regardless of the length of the program), payable to the Alabama Public Health Association, when returning the Sign-in Sheet and Evaluation to the Alabama Department of Public Health. The Continuing Education certificate will be mailed after the payment, the completed Sign-in Sheet and Evaluation have been received. Detailed instructions can be found on the program's Sign-in Sheet. Continuing education certificates will be granted to nurses for exactly one year and exactly two years for social workers from the date of the live broadcast.
Nurses and social workers can also watch the On Demand version of a program receive continuing education for the same one and two year length of time.
