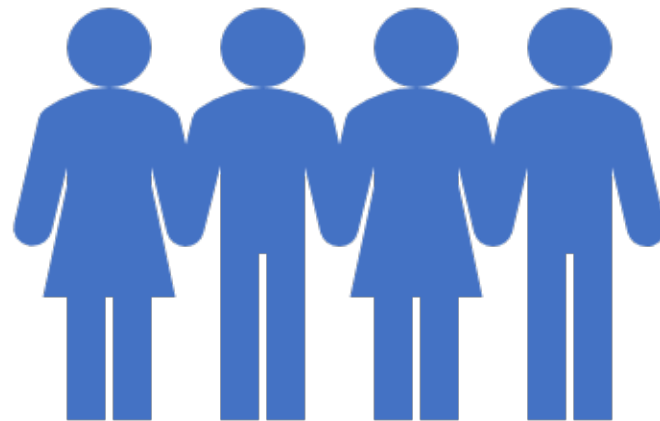

What is FLccSC?


