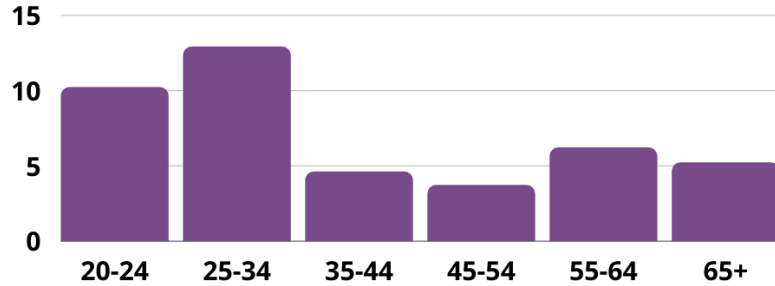

Percent Unemployed by Race and Income

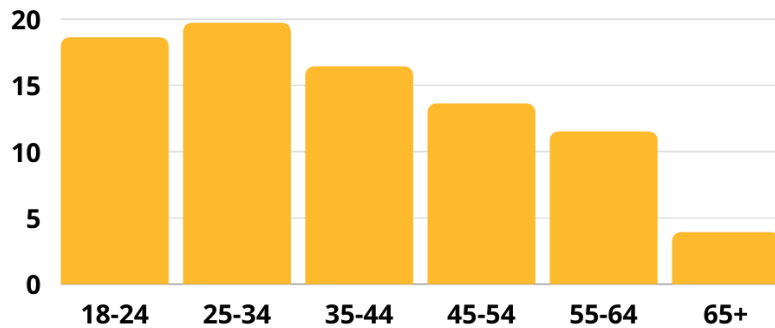
The state average is 5.6 percent.



Access to Care

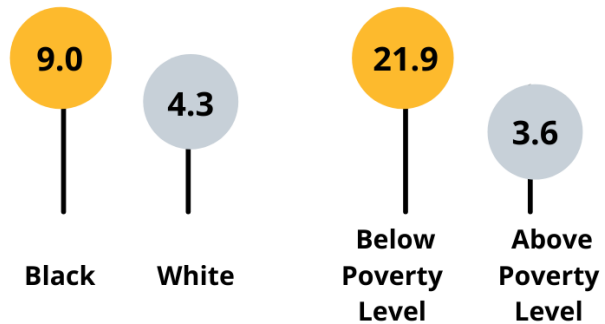
Percent who Needed to See A Doctor But Could Not Afford by Age

The state average is 9.5 percent.



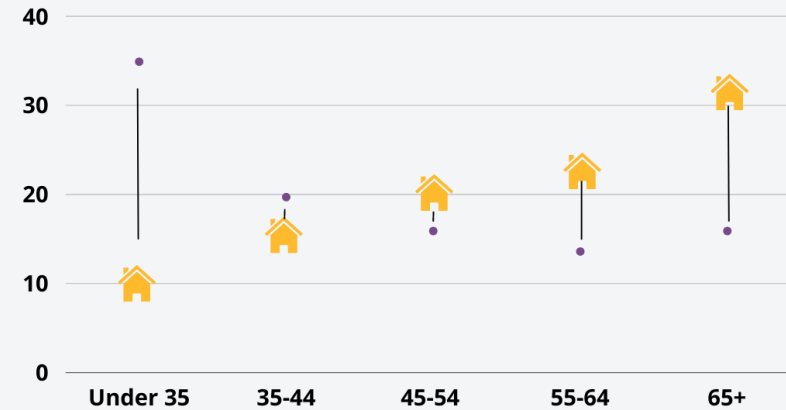
Housing

The state average of home ownership is 69.2 percent.

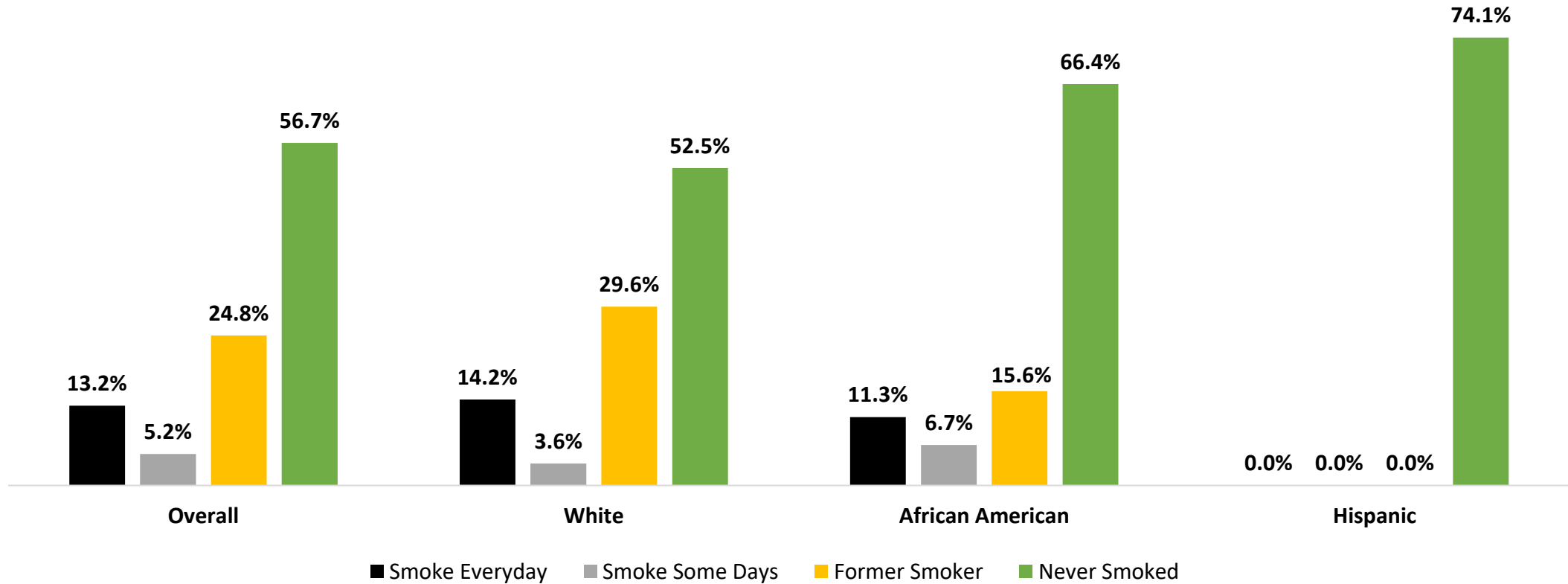


Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS) Data Disclaimer:

- The information selected here is from a represented population of Alabama adults. Currently, all states collect BRFSS data to help them establish and track state and local health objectives, plan health programs, implement disease prevention and health promotion activities, and monitor trends. Nearly two thirds of states use BRFSS data to support health-related legislative efforts.
- The annual cross-sectional survey is collected through landline and cellphone delivered questions.

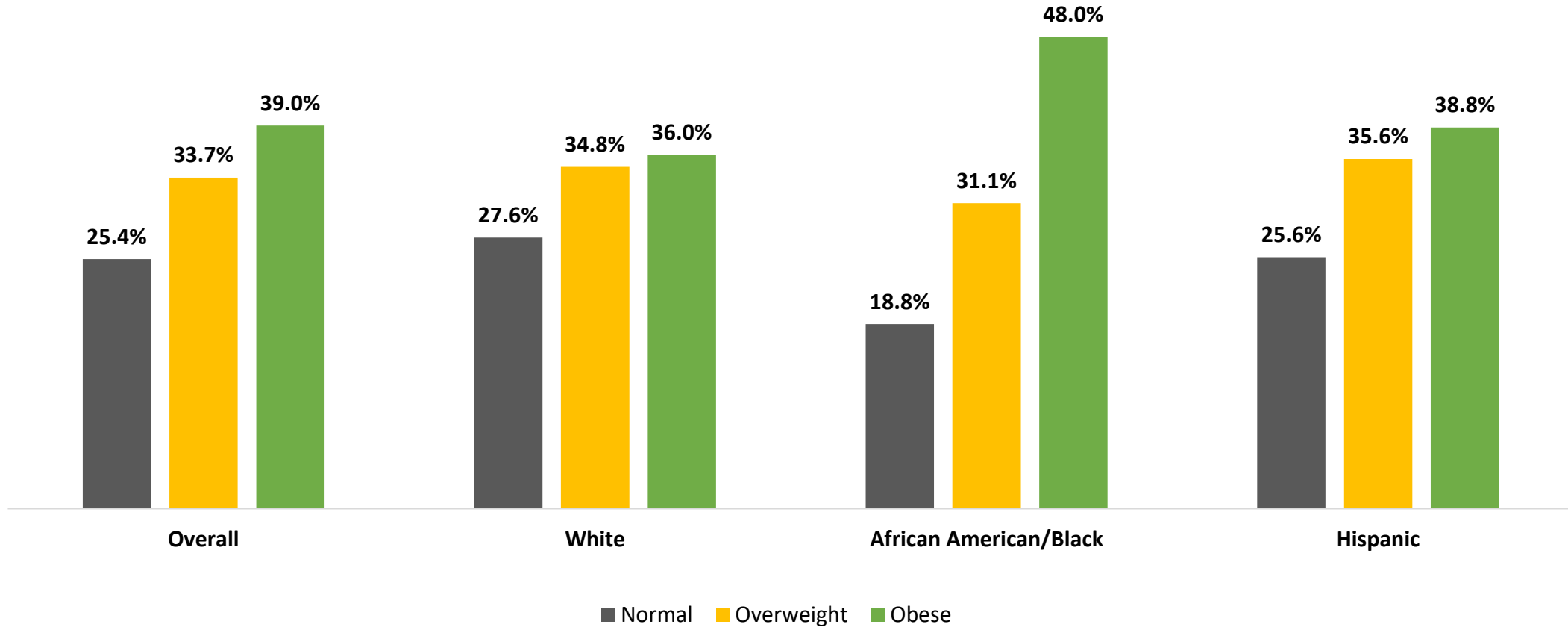
Adult smoking status in the past 12 months

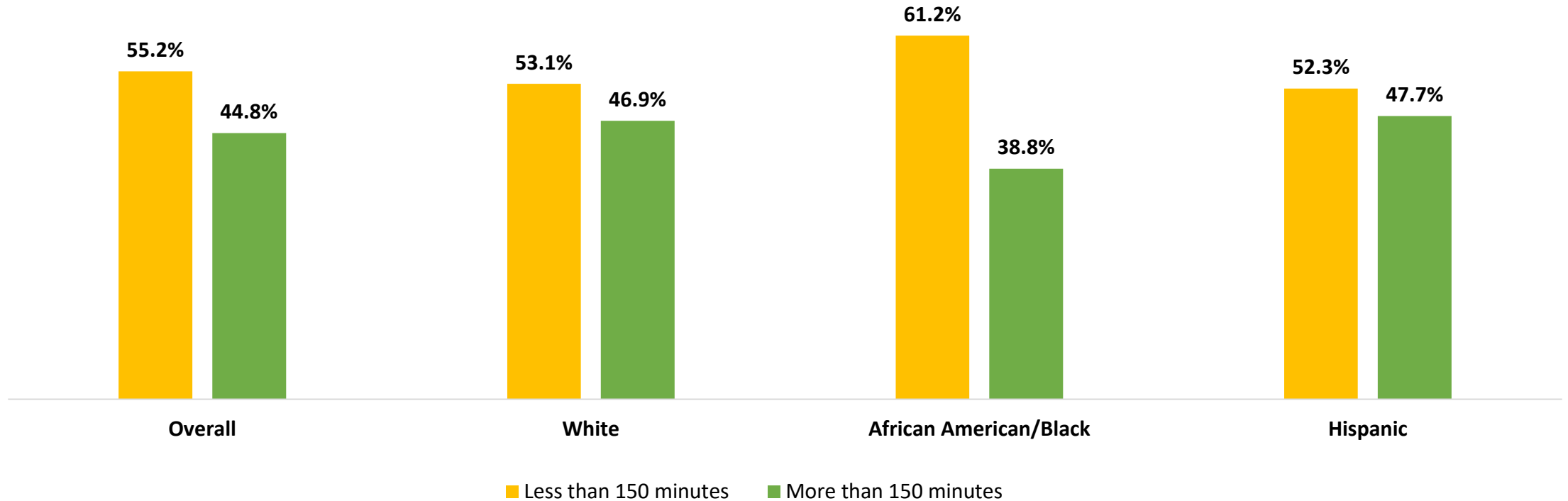
Adult BMI category in the past 12 months

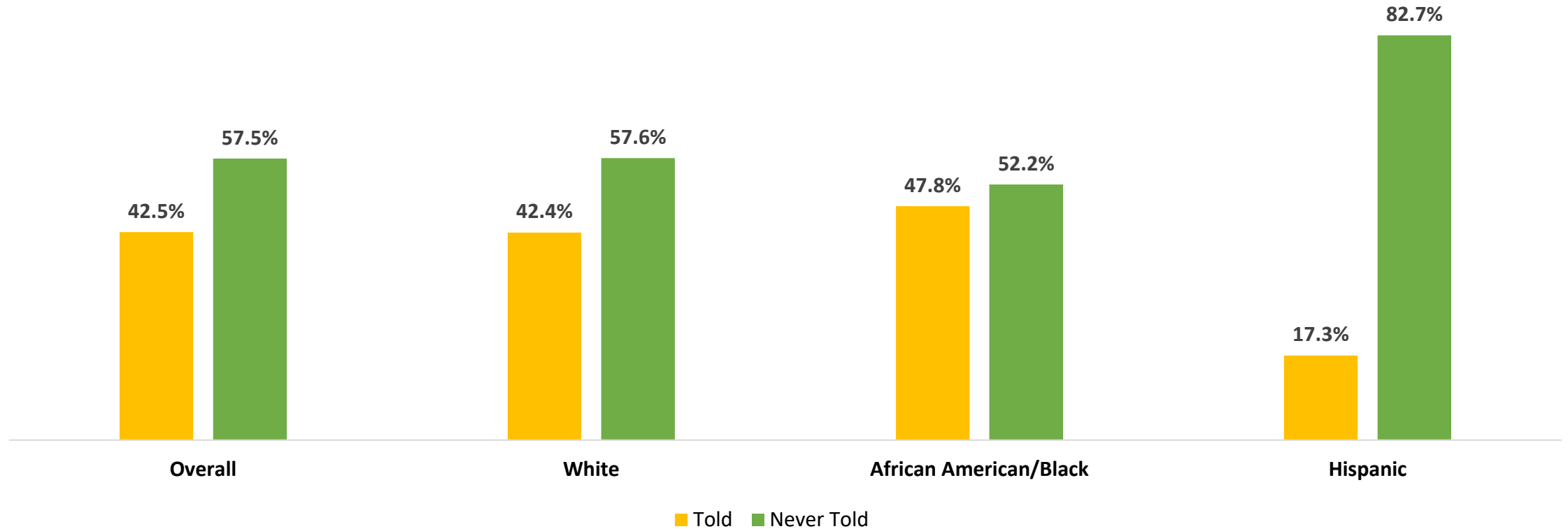
Adults who participated in physical activity in the past 12 months

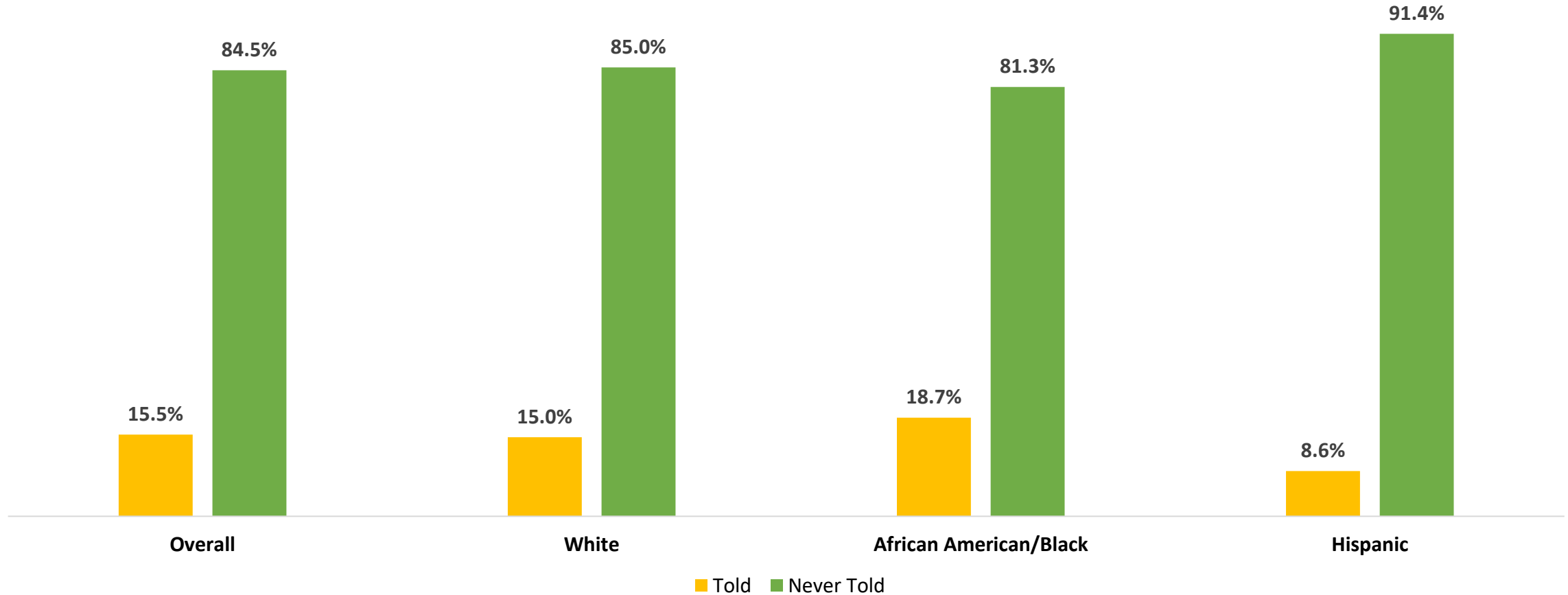
Adults who were told they have high blood pressure

Adults who were told they have diabetes

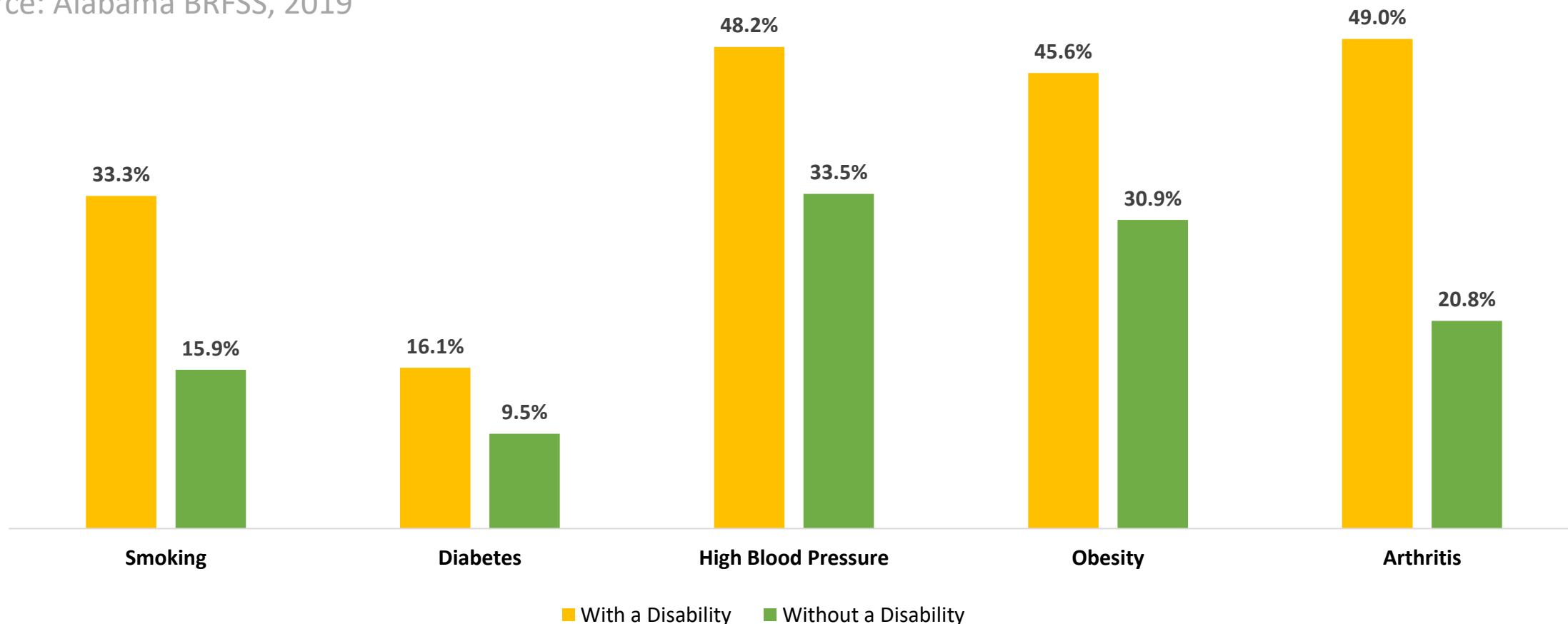
