JANUARY 2021 TO DECEMBER 2024

This document contains statistics of reportable STDs in Alabama from January 2021 to December 2024. The report presents the impact of Chlamydia, Gonorrhea, and Syphilis on Race/Ethnicity, gender, and age groups in Alabama.

The report shows STDs in the eight public health districts in the state. The status of STDs in counties within each district is listed to show the number of cases, percentage, and rates.

The recommended and alternative treatment of Chlamydia, Gonorrhea, and Syphilis by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) is presented in this report.

CHLAMYDIAL INFECTION:

Positive Test and Presumptive Treatment:

Doxycycline 100 mg PO twice daily for 7 days

During Pregnancy: Azithromycin 1 g PO as a single dose

RECOMMENDED: UNCOMPLICATED GONOCOCCAL INFECTIONS:

Persons Weighing <150 kg (300 lb): **Ceftriaxone 500 mg IM** as a single dose

Persons Weighing ≥150 kg (300 lb): **Ceftriaxone 1 g IM** as a single dose

Alternative Regimens if Ceftriaxone is not Available:

Gentamicin 240 mg IM as a single dose, PLUS **Azithromycin 2 g** PO as a single dose **OR**

Cefixime 800 mg PO as a single dose **PLUS**

Doxycycline 100 mg PO Twice Daily for 7 Days, if Chlamydia test result is Unknown

Azithromycin 1 g as a single dose, If pregnant

NOTE: Reliable Alternative Treatment for **Pharyngeal Gonorrhea** not Available. For a True Ceftriaxone allergy, consult an infectious diseases specialist.

PRIMARY, SECONDARY, EARLY LATENT SYPHILIS (NOT DURING PREGNANCY)

Benzathine penicillin G 2.4 mu IM as a single dose.

Alternative Regimen for TRUE Penicillin Allergy (Not During Pregnancy)

Doxycycline 100 mg PO BID x 14 days **OR**

Tetracycline 500 mg PO QID x 14 days

Late Latent Syphilis

Benzathine penicillin G 7.2 mu total as 3 doses of 2.4 mu IM each at 1-week intervals

Alternative Regimen for TRUE Penicillin Allergy (Not During Pregnancy)

Doxycycline 100 mg PO BID x 28 days **OR**

Tetracycline 500 mg PO QID x 28 days

SYPHILIS TREATMENT DURING PREGNANCY

Due to missed opportunities resulting in a significant number of cases of congenital syphilis in Alabama, ADPH is recommending the following treatment regimens, including retreatment of women who were previously treated syphilis before pregnancy.

All pregnant women with signs and symptoms and/or a positive syphilis test result must be treated, as detailed below, at least 30 days before delivery to prevent congenital syphilis:

PRIMARY SYPHILIS, SECONDARY SYPHILIS, OR EARLY NON-PRIMARY AND NON-SECONDARY SYPHILIS:

Benzathine penicillin 2.4 million units IM every week for two weeks at 5-7 days interval.

SYPHILIS UNKNOWN DURATION, LATE SYPHILIS, OR PREVIOUSLY TREATED POSITIVE BEFORE PREGNANCY:

Benzathine penicillin 2.4 million units IM every week for three weeks at 5-7 days interval.

NOTE: Pregnant women with TRUE penicillin allergy should be desensitized and treated with penicillin
