

Alabama Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) Program Nurse Supervisor (NS) Breastfeeding Coordinator



Job Summary

The Breastfeeding Coordinator is a State WIC Office position that coordinates breastfeeding promotion and support activities with other Alabama WIC Program operations and external agencies/programs and assists with WIC Nutrition Services activities such as the Breastfeeding Peer Counselor Program coordination, Value Enhanced Nutrition Assessment (VENA), outreach, quality assurance, and other WIC activities.

Education and Experience

- B.S. degree in Nursing from an accredited college or university and three (3) years of professional nursing experience including two (2) years of supervisory experience OR M.S. degree in Nursing, Public Health, or a closely related field from an accredited college or university and B.S. degree in Nursing from an accredited college or university and two (2) years of professional nursing experience including one year of supervisory experience (required)
 *Nurse Supervisors holding only an Associates degree cannot be considered
- Alabama Professional Nursing License as Issued by the Alabama Board of Nursing(required)
- Must have specialized training in lactation management and care or will complete such state approved specialized training within first year of employment. Available certifications include International Board Certified Lactation Consultant (IBCLC) and/or Certified Lactation Counselor (CLC).
- Experience with Microsoft applications such as Word, Microsoft Excel, etc. (required)
- WIC experience (preferred)
- Must be able to travel in and out of state to attend required meetings and conferences (required)
- Experience with managing multiple projects (required)

Job Responsibilities

- Coordinates communication and networking activities with Alabama hospitals and other statewide breastfeeding stakeholders so that consistent information and strong relationships are enhanced.
- Develops and implements an annual statewide breastfeeding promotion plan, including breastfeeding education/counseling materials and resources to meet the needs of WIC clinic staff and participants.
- Provides breastfeeding training, annually and as needed, such that WIC staff and other health care providers receive information for breastfeeding education, promotion and support.
- Assesses the needs and uses; and coordinates delivery, including bid process, of WIC

breastfeeding supplies and equipment so that WIC staff have adequate resources to assist participants.

- Coordinates and directs the Breastfeeding Peer Counseling Program so that the Program is compliant with federal regulations.
- Responds to emergency and disaster assignments when called to duty
