


CANISTER

ADS / 1.5 oz – Stream Delivery

- Compact, easy-to-carry aerosol can
- Comes with a quick-aim safety cap and an integrated belt clip for easy access

- Eyes
- Respiratory
- Skin

EFFECTS OF ADS ON ANIMALS

General signs in affected animals are:

- Burning in the Throat
- Wheezing
- Dry Cough
- Shortness of Breath
- Gagging & Gasping
- Inability to Vocalize

PSYCHOLOGICAL EFFECTS

Disorientation

Anxiety

Panic

Note: These effects can be greatly reduced if the animal has been exposed to ADS previously.

FIRST AID MEASURES

Wash	IF ON SKIN (or hair): Wash with soap and water. Take off any contaminated clothing and launder before reuse.
Rinse	IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing for at least 10 minutes or until satisfied.
Move	IF INHALED: Move to fresh air. Administer oxygen if breathing is difficult. If breathing has stopped give artificial respiration and seek medical attention immediately.
Do not induce	IF INGESTED (or swallowed): Do not induce vomiting unless instructed to do so by a medical professional. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

ADS DECON KIT

Sabre Decon Cleanse & Soothe

- > 1 four (4) ounce bottle each of Cleanse & Soothe
- > Cleanse is Step 1 and Soothe is Step 2
- > Reduce decontamination time & limits reactivation/OC hangover
- > Decon Kit must be used properly (follow manufacturer's instruction)
- > Sabre Decon process takes time to complete
- > 2-year shelf life

ADS DECON KIT

➤ **Step 1 Cleanse: Help prevent the "OC Hangover" by removing dead skin cells**

- ❑ First step, complete a thorough rinse of the face for about 30 seconds with water
- ❑ Next, squeeze a 2-inch diameter of Sabre cleanse in your hands and rub over face for approximately 30 seconds
(DO NOT RUB DIRECTLY OVER EYES!)
- ❑ Rinse face again for about 15-30 seconds with your eyes closed (repeat 5 times)
- ❑ The cleanse allows the soap to get into your pores by removing dead skin cells
- ❑ OC hangover effects can start back once you begin to perspire or take a hot shower

ADS DECON KIT

➤ **Step 2 Soothes: Reduces Redness, Swelling & Pain**

- ❑ Decon both eyes (1 eye at a time) for 5 minutes each
- ❑ Thoroughly flush out each eye by running water from the bridge of the nose to the outside of the face
- ❑ Dry your hands and pat dry your face with a towel or paper towels
- ❑ Apply about 1 diameter of Sabre Soothe to your hands and pat all over your facial area
- ❑ Do not rinse the Sabre Soothe off your face; let it air dry
- ❑ Once the Sabre Soothe dries, and the pain returns after 2 to 5 minutes, repeat the process if necessary
- ❑ Never rub your eyes during the entire process

REQUIREMENTS TO CARRY ADS

OC Training

- Employees working in the field
- Employees may request authorization to carry ADS while on duty
- Must complete all required training and receive authorization from the Department
- Only use Department issued ADS as a defense measure while on duty
- Employee's immediate supervisor shall ensure that all requirements are met by the employee before issuing ADS

PRIOR TO USE OF ADS

Prior To Using OC Spray

- > Attempt to remove yourself from imminent threat or danger zone
- > Announce for the threat to stop with verbal commands if possible
- > Consider the potential effects on bystanders and yourself



ADS USE OF FORCE

When To Use OC Spray

- > Only use for self defense
- > Employee may use when you reasonably believe that it is necessary to protect yourself from an imminent threat from an animal
- > Once the threat is incapacitated ADS is no longer justified

INAPPROPRIATE USE OF ADS

- ADS shall never be used as punishment, discipline, retaliation or treatment
- Any employee who observes another employee using ADS inappropriately shall report the incident to their immediate supervisor at the time of the misuse or reasonably thereafter.
- If a person is injured, immediately call 9-1-1
- Employees who violate this policy may be subject to disciplinary action or criminal prosecution

REPORTING USE OF ADS

Recommended topics to include in your report:

- Contact information of any witnesses to the incident
- Verbal dialogue before, during, and after use of ADS
- Description of the animal at issue
- Animal's response (or lack of) to commands prior to use of ADS
- Describe the encounter and how protocol was followed; including but not limited to, details of your attempts to avoid use of ADS, techniques used and the results

USE OF ADS POLICY REVIEW



Employee must be authorized to carry ADS and must complete required training



ADS used for self defense strictly against animals & the use must be reasonably proportionate to the need



Whenever possible discharge upwind in low wind conditions and avoid entering sprayed area



Maintain a safe distance (at least 4 to 6 feet). Use single spray bursts (between 1 & 3 seconds)




Complete an ARIA on the day of the incident




Employee must give an Incident Notice to the property owner on the day of the incident but no later than by the end of the next workday



EXPIRATION

- Typically expires 3-4 years after purchase of ADS
- All defense sprays and cartridges shall be replaced annually to ensure the most potent spray possible
- If cartridges are not date stamped, the date of purchase should be written on the can with indelible ink
- Decon Kits should also be replaced before expiration dates
