3. Learn about community education and outreach initiatives implemented by the UAB Minority Health Research Center.
4. Recognize signs and symptoms of substance abuse, different types of drugs, and programs available to address chemical addiction.
5. Understand different types of mental illness and available treatment options.
6. Receive an overview of different sexually transmitted diseases affecting men, risk factors, counseling and testing, and prevention issues.
7. Learn general information about viral hepatitis, prevention recommendations, risk factors, and its impact on the liver.
