Medicare loses billions of dollars each year due to fraud, errors, and abuse. Approximately 250,000 Medicare beneficiaries have had their medical identify stolen or misused. Financial and health care scams are on the rise, and new Medicare cards will be mailed in June to help combat this problem. Program faculty will provide information on the new cards, discuss the top senior financial scams and provide important information that will help you be a smart fraud detector to help your clients and family.
