*Human trafficking (HT) is growing at an alarming rate, particularly in the southeastern United States. The strip of I-20 between Atlanta and Birmingham is now considered to be the Human Trafficking Super Highway. Identifying a victim of Human Trafficking can be difficult because the signs tend to be subtle. This training will teach providers not only how to recognize red flags associated with victims of human trafficking, but will include the safest and most effective methods of helping the victims, including who to contact and where to refer victims for assistance.*
