Prescription drug costs have a substantial impact on budgets and one cost saving strategy is bulk or "aggregate" purchasing. The Public Health Service Act drug discount program was established in Section 340B of the Veteran's Health Care Act of 1992, and is designed to offer pharmaceuticals at discounted rates.
