## **OBJECTIVES**

- Changes in Public Health Care Coordination with the ending of the Patient 1st Program.
- Overview EPSDT Care Coordination Services.
- Coding / documentation in ACORN for the EPSDT Care Coordination Program.

## **SHIFT TO NEW PROGRAM**

- Patient 1<sup>st</sup> Care Coordination ends September 30, 2019.
- Public Health Social Workers will continue to provide services to the following under EPSDT:
  - Children with elevated lead levels.
  - Newborns with failed hearing screenings.
  - Newborns who have failed required screenings (metabolics).

## **ELEVATED LEAD**

- Referrals received on children under 21 identified with possible elevated lead levels.
- Purpose:
  - Assist families in scheduling to be retested.
  - Educate families on dangers of lead and eliminating lead in their environment.
  - Follow up until lead levels are below 5.
  - Work with Environmentalists, as needed.

## **NEWBORN HEARING**

- Referrals received on newborns that have failed their hearing screening.
- Purpose:
  - Assist family in scheduling a second hearing screening and diagnostic testing.
  - Make referrals as needed, such as Early Intervention.

## NEWBORN SCREENINGS

- Referrals received on newborns who have failed their required screenings and the family is non-responsive to initial contact attempts.
- Purpose:
  - Locating families of newborns.
  - Educate parents/caregivers on importance of retesting and follow up.
  - Make referrals as needed such as transportation assistance, Early Intervention.

## HIGHLIGHTS

- Protocol remains the same – refer to EPSDT Protocol for additional information.
- Require a CHR#
- No Prior Authorization
- Most significant changes - different Service Area Codes

  - Lead (Medicaid recipients) – 36
  - Lead Grant (Non-Medicaid recipients) – 34
  - Newborn Hearing (Medicaid recipients) – 35
