WHAT IS A FOOD DESERT?

A food desert refers to a residential area with no immediate access to quality foods that support a healthy diet but often served by plenty of fast food places.



Benefits of a healthy food community include:

- Supports local farmers
- Makes fresh produce available
- Promotes community unity
- Lowers health care cost due to healthier lifestyles

Creating a Healthy Food Community Includes:

- Having easy access to fresh fruits and vegetables
- Improving locations of grocery stores
- Improving selections of foods offered at convenience stores and gas stations
- Limiting the number of fast food outlets available
- Specifying land use in planning meetings

Creating a Healthy Food Community Includes:

- Physical access-Healthy food stores may be located in an area that is hard to get to for the general public.
- Financial access-Fresh produce may be seen as too expensive or the shopper cannot afford the bus fare to remote shops selling fresh foods.
- Knowledge-The consumer may lack cooking knowledge, or have the idea that eating a healthy diet isn't important.
