LESS SODA

Calories: 240 in 20 ounces
Contains over 16 tsp. of added sugar
Not a good source of vitamins or minerals



Limit servings

LIMIT 100% JUICE

Calories: 60 in 4 ounces
Good source of vitamin C and potassium



Only 4-6 ounces daily

1% OR FAT-FREE MILK

Calories: 90
Good source of calcium, potassium,
vitamin D, and protein



2 cups daily (2-3 years old)
2.5 cups daily (4-8 years old)
3 cups daily (9-19 years old)

Calories: 0
