### Instructions to Patients for Collection of Clean Catch Urine Sample

- 1. Wash hands with soap and water.
- 2. Cleanse the genital area using the following procedure.

#### Male

- If not circumcised, retract the foreskin before cleansing.
- Wipe the end of the penis using a towelette.

#### Female

- Squat over the toilet and use the fingers of one hand to separate and hold the folds of the skin in the genital area.
- Clean the urinary opening and surrounding area with a towelette, using the other hand, moving from front to back. Repeat the cleansing process using a second towelette.
- 3. Discard the towelettes in the trash can. DO NOT THROW TOWELETTES IN THE TOILET.
- 4. Handle the urine collection container (clean, unused, disposable cup) carefully and do not touch the inside
- 5. Begin urinating into the toilet bowl. After urine has flowed for several seconds into the toilet, begin to urinate in the collection container. When the container is about ½ full, remove the container from the urine stream and continue urinating into the toilet.
- 6. Close the specimen container and give to the medical provider.

**Note**: Strongly emphasize to the patient the importance of collecting the specimen properly. Otherwise, the specimen will be unsatisfactory for testing.
