You maybe eligible for free
or low-cost screenings:

- **LOW-INCOME**
- **UNINSURED**
- **UNDERSERVED**

The Alabama Breast & Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program (ABCCEDP) provides free breast and cervical cancer screenings and diagnostic services to women who meet the following criteria:

- A resident of Alabama (have an Alabama address)
- Between 40-64 years old*
- Have a household income at or below 250 percent of the Federal Poverty Level
- Uninsured or underinsured.

Free services include a pelvic exam, pap smear, clinical breast exam, mammogram, and diagnostic services such as an ultrasound, colposcopy, or biopsy, if needed.

*You may also be eligible for a cervical screening if you are 21-39 years old and have had a tubal ligation or partial hysterectomy with a cervix still remaining.
