(a) Any student in a public school under 10 the jurisdiction of a local board of education or in a 11 nonpublic school may possess and apply federal Food and Drug 12 Administration regulated over-the-counter sunscreen at school 13 and at school-based events notwithstanding any other provision 14 of law, including any rule of the State Board of Education or 15 the State Board of Nursing. 16 (b) No rule of the State Board of Education or the 17 State Board of Nursing shall apply to the possession or use of 18 federal Food and Drug Administration regulated 19 over-the-counter sunscreen by students at a public or 20 nonpublic school. 21 (c) Any student, parent, or guardian requesting a 22 school board employee to apply sunscreen to a student shall 23

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present to the nurse a Parent Prescriber Authorization Form

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(PPA) containing a parent or guardian signature. A physician
signature or physician order shall not be required.
Section 2. This act shall become effective
immediately following its passage and approval by the
