**What's New?**  Try the new 10g layout

All users are strongly encouraged to use the new layout in CureMD. To use the new feature, click the toggle button next to “What’s New” at the top of the bar. Users can switch between old and enhanced 10g layout by turning ‘On’ and ‘Off’ the toggle button. In the new layout, the main items are repositioned to the left-hand side of the screen in a single vertical view containing all the modules, listings, and customization options.
