Prolonged close contact with a COVID-19 patient who was not wearing a face mask

Wearing All Recommended PPE	Low	Self w/Supervision	No

Work Restrictions: HCP excluded from work for 14 days after last exposure.

Active: HCP restricted from work in any healthcare setting. If they develop a fever or respiratory symptoms consistent with COVID-19, they should immediately self-isolate and notify ADPH.

Self w/Supervision: HCP should perform self-monitoring with delegated supervision until 14 days after the last potential exposure. Asymptomatic HCP in this category are not restricted from work.
