

INFLUENZA

QUICK GUIDE FOR INFLUENZA SPECIMEN SUBMISSION

If influenza A or B is detected, specific virus lineage will be determined. If influenza A or B is not detected, specimens will be tested for other pathogens.

COLLECT

Collect 2 specimens per week from patients with ILI from separate households plus any from the list below:

Hospitalized patients

Pregnant women

Patients with recent international travel

Patients reporting exposure to pigs

Patients reporting exposure to backyard flock

Submit specimens year round

ILI symptoms include: fever of at least 100° F, oral or equivalent, and cough and/or sore throat, without a known cause other than influenza

SUBMIT

Log in to your facility's State Lab Web Portal

Print a bar code for shipping

Patient results will be received electronically

SHIP

Specimens must be received within 7 days of collection.
