



# Alabama's Weekly Influenza Report

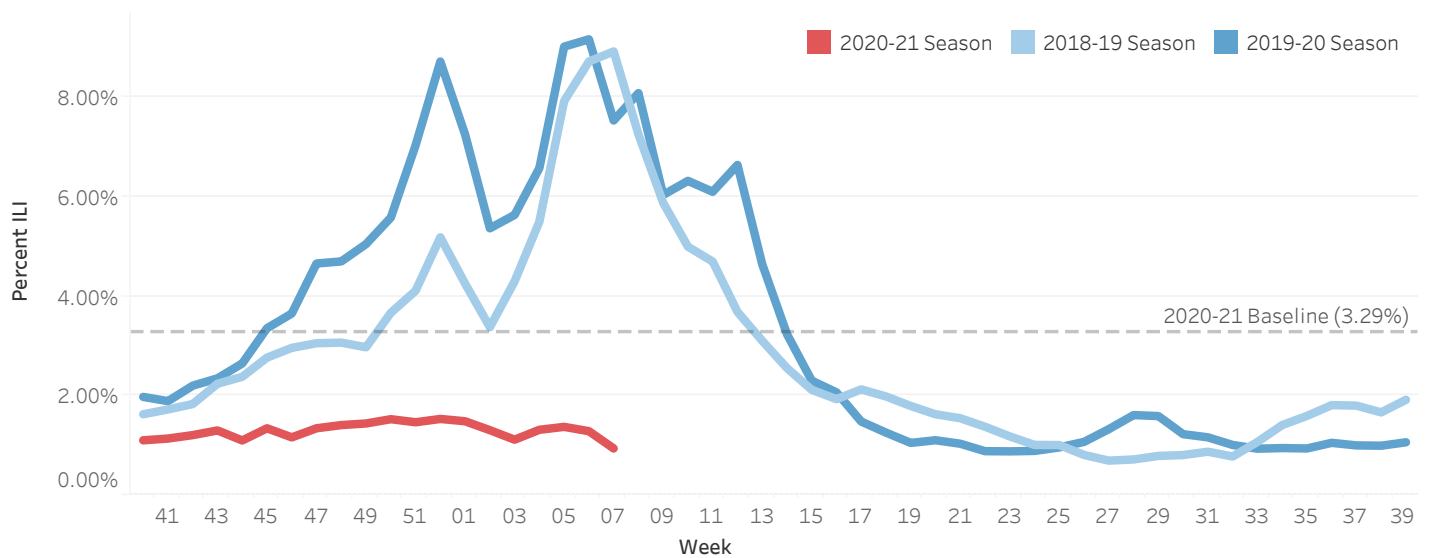
Season: 2020-2021 | Week 7: February 14, 2021 - February 20, 2021



## Takeaway Points

- => Statewide influenza-like illness (ILI) is at **0.94%**, which is a **slight decrease** as compared to last week. This percentage is below Alabama's 2020-2021 season baseline of 3.29%.
- => **Two districts** (Northeastern, West Central) have already seen **influenza B** sporadically in its communities in the last three weeks.
- => **Four influenza-associated non-pediatric deaths** have been reported this season.
- => **Human rhinovirus/enterovirus, Respiratory syncytial virus, Adenovirus, Human coronavirus 229E, and Human coronavirus NL63** are currently circulating throughout Alabama and can present similar symptoms as influenza.
- => **No influenza or ILI outbreak(s)** were reported during the week ending February 20.
- => **Vaccination** also is important for health care workers who care for people at higher risk to keep from spreading flu to them. This is especially true for people who work in long-term care facilities, which are home to patients vulnerable to flu and COVID-19.
