



# Alabama's Weekly Influenza Report

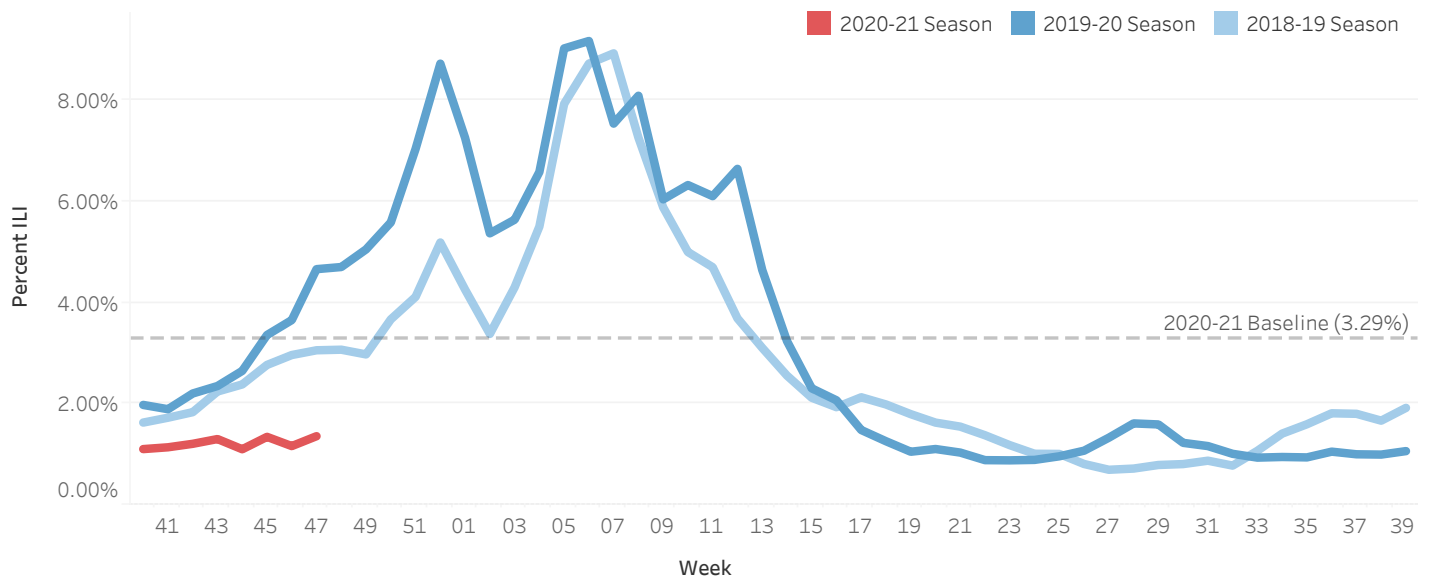


Season: 2020-2021 | Week 47: November 15, 2020 - November 21, 2020

## Takeaway Points

- => Statewide influenza-like illness (ILI) is at **1.36%**, which is a **slight increase** as compared to last week. This percentage is below Alabama's 2020-2021 season baseline of 3.29%.
- => **Three districts** (Jefferson, Northeastern, West Central) have already seen **influenza A and B** sporadically in its communities in the last three weeks.
- => **One influenza-associated non-pediatric death** has been reported this season.
- => **No influenza or ILI outbreak(s)** were reported during the week ending November 21.
- => People with **flu** are most contagious in the first 3-4 days after their illness begins. Some people, especially **young children and people with weakened immune systems**, might be able to infect others for an even longer time.
- => It's not too late to **get vaccinated**. Flu activity is still low and CDC recommends vaccination continue throughout the fall and winter.
