





## Where Do You Usually Buy Your Disposable Device or Refills for Your Electronic Cigarette or Vapor Device?

- 51.0% Vape Shop
- 14.5% Convenience Store
- 11.1% Online/Internet
- 5.6% Tobacco Smokeshop or Specialty Store
- 17.6% Other (e.g., gas station, someone else buys them)

#### What is the Main Reason You Tried an E-Cigarette?

- 38.2% Wanted to quit cigarettes or other tobacco use
- 13.6% Curious
- 10.9% Social activity/for fun/someone invited me to try
- 7.0% Flavor sounded good
- 6.5% Thought it would be safer than cigarettes
- 2.6% Wanted to cut back on cigarettes or other tobacco
- 1.5% Wanted to save money
- .9% Doesn't have distinctive odor
- 18.1% Other (e.g., got it free, easier access, smelled good, out of cigarettes, friends/others were doing it

### Secondhand exposure to vapor

- 23.9% -- Breathed vapor outdoors from others at work in past 30 days
- 16.0% -- Breathed vapor indoors from others in past 7 days
  - 6.7% -- Entrance of a building
  - 6.2% -- Lobby, hallway, other common areas of a building
  - 4.9% -- Someone else's home
  - 3.8% -- Own home
  - 3.7% -- Shopping mall
  - 2.6% -- Someone else's car
  - 1.9% -- In your office
  - 1.8% -- Family car
  - 1.5% -- Indoor sporting area
  - 1.5% -- Stairwell of a building
