

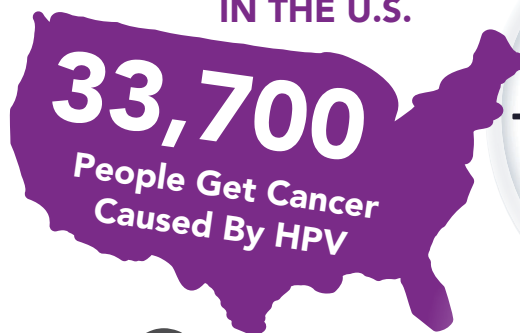

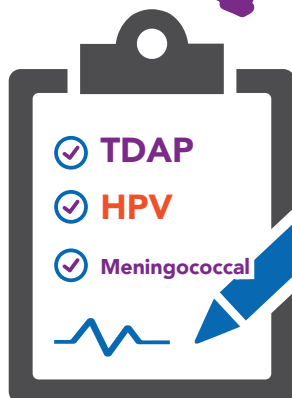

The HPV Vaccine Works Best at Age 11 or 12

The vaccine provides the most protection if given before a person becomes sexually active.
