

CHILDREN AGES 5-9 ARE MOST LIKELY TO BE BITTEN.

TEACH CHILDREN SAFETY AROUND DOGS:

- 1. Do not approach a dog you do not know.
- 2. Do not scream or run from a dog.
- 3. Freeze when approached or knocked over by a dog.
- 4. Avoid direct eye contact with a dog.
- 5. Do not disturb a dog that is sleeping, eating, or caring for puppies.

Any bite or scratch should be reported to a physician or your local health department.
